RECYCLING AT HOME

Remember to:

- Wash and squash all containers and flatten cardboard boxes before putting them in your recycling bin, to save space
- If you have large cardboard boxes, break them smaller pieces
- Put your bin out by 6am on collection day

We collect your recycling bin

- Every two weeks. [Check your collection day here](#)

Your recycling

- Is sent to a recycling facility to be sorted
- Is turned back into bottles, paper, card, clothing, insulation and even furniture
