Skip Licence Application to place a skip on the Highway Highways Act 1980 Section 169, 172 & 173

It is the responsibility of the skip hire company to make sure they have a licence for the skip if it is placed on the Highway. Applications are to be made by the skip company rather than the builder or site owner/homeowner.

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. At no time can a skip be located on private property without the consent of the council as vehicle crossings are only suitable for domestic use and not for HGV access and will be punishable under a FPN. 2. The offence of depositing a builder's skip on a highway without the permission of the council is punishable by fine of up to £1000. 3. Skips placed in a controlled parking bay may be subject to an additional charge for bay suspensions. 4. Where a skip is identified that does not have a permit, the Council may issue a permit whether or not a prosecution is deemed appropriate. The fee for such a "retrospective" application is twice the initial fee. Officers will exercise discretion to make the standard charge where there is evidence that the company genuinely endeavoured to apply for the permit in advance. 5. Failure to complete the appropriate sections in full may result in a delay in processing your application. 6. Please allow at least 5 working days before skip delivery is due for us to process your application. 7. "Owner" in relation to a builders skip which is the subject of a hiring agreement, being an agreement for a hiring of not less than one month, or a hire purchase agreement, means the person in possession of the skip under that agreement (Highway Act 1980 Section 139(11)). 8. Inspections are carried out periodically both in and out of normal working hours. 9. Persons found not to be complying with the conditions of any licence will be reported for possible legal action. 10. The licence is only valid for the period stated on it. This will be for up to 2 weeks at a time. An application for renewal must be received at least 5 working days before the expiry of the existing licence. 11. The power to levy a charge is derived from Regulation 3 of the Local Authority (Transport Charges) Regulations 1998. 12. The power for the council to make conditions is in section 139 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 65 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. <p>Please note any additional special conditions attached to the licence, subject to a site meeting.</p>
