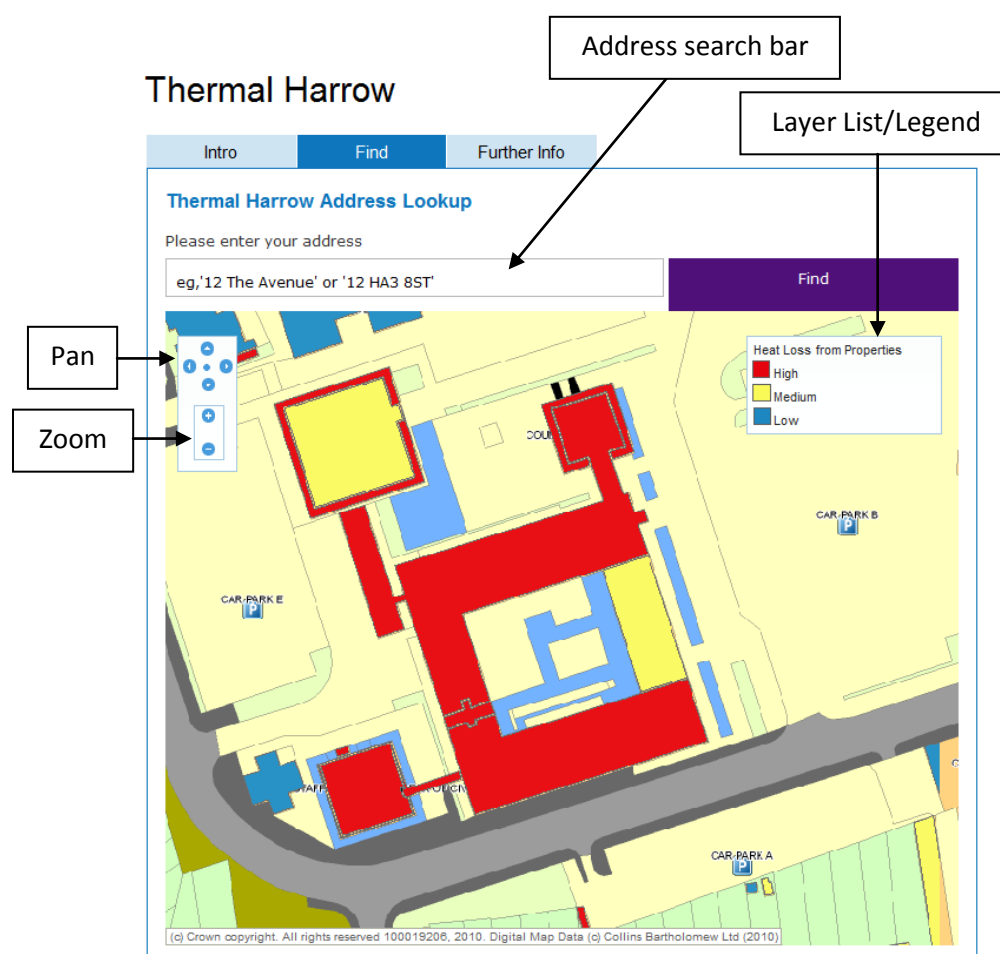


Thermal Harrow Address Lookup Guide

The Thermal Harrow Address Lookup is a tool designed to allow users to search for their homes, identify their homes and identify if their homes have a greater than average thermal emissivity (heat loss). For a greater versatility of application or more indepth thermal data on the Borough of Harrow please use the *Thermal Harrow Open Data Application*.

The Application

The application is available to access as an embedded map on the Harrow Council Website (http://www.harrow.gov.uk/info/100006/environment/1514/thermal_harrow) to allow easy access to the public with the starting screen being shown below with its key features.



Features

Address Lookup – enter the first part of the address, whole address or postcode you are looking for.

Zoom – allows adjustments to different scales.

Pan – panning allows you to move around the map (this can also be done by left clicking and dragging on the map itself).

Legend – displays the visible layers and the key representing what each symbol means.

Layers

OS Background Maps – an Ordnance Survey colour backing layer, overlaid with Local Land and Property Gazetteer (LLPG) building numbers and Harrow road names.

OS Master Map Polygons – Ordnance Survey Master Map polygons with their assigned thermal values, symbolised to show whether the mean (average) thermal value within the property is higher, the same or lower than the average of the Borough.
