Statutory Listed Buildings

The 49th List of Buildings of Special Architectural & Historic Interest & Subsequent Amendments

The listing of buildings of special architectural or historic interest is the responsibility of the Secretary of State for National Heritage Under Section 1 of the Planning (Listed Buildings & Conservation Areas) Act 1990. The list is organised on a local authority area basis and includes an entry for each building or structure with address, grading, date of listing and usually a brief description.

Buildings are either listed as part of a national survey programme, spot listed, or added to the list by the Secretary of State following a Building Preservation Notice served by a local authority. In compiling or adding to the list, the Secretary of State considers the building itself and any respect in which its exterior contributes to the architectural or historic interest of any group of buildings of which it forms part, and the desirability of preserving, on the grounds of architectural or historic interest, any feature of the building consisting of a man made object or structure fixed to the building, or forming part of the land and comprised within the cartilage of the building (P(LB & CA)A 1990, \$1(3)).

Selection of buildings is carried out according to specific criteria, published by the Department of the Environment and Department of National Heritage (currently Planning Policy Guidance 15: Planning and the Historic Environment). Buildings and structures are graded I, II* and II according to their relative importance.

The Borough was fully surveyed in 1983, although there have been several amendments and additions since, added to the 49th list. There are 281 entries on the statutory list for the London Borough of Harrow, 66 of these have more than one building included in this entry. This list includes 16 ecclesiastical buildings and over 40 structures (e.g. telephone kiosks, gates, graves and mile posts, etc.). The list includes 4 grade I buildings and 16 grade II*.

It should be noted that every part of a listed building is in law equally 'listed'. The interior is thus just as much listed as the exterior regardless of the grade of listing. A listed building is also defined to include any object or structure fixed to the building or in its cartilage. This should be borne in mind when considering works to outbuildings in the grounds or even the historic curtilage of a listed building.

Listed Building Consent is required from the local planning authority for any works which are considered to affect the special architectural or historic interest of the building. Advice on whether proposed works would require consent should be sought from the Council's Conservation Department. The carrying out of unauthorised works, i.e. without having obtained Listed Building Consent is a criminal offence.
