#### 1 Context

The Harrow IDP was found sound as part of adopted Core Strategy in February 2012. The CIL regulations state that:

'The CIL examination should not re-open infrastructure planning that has already been submitted in support of a sound core strategy DPD or LDP (or in London, a formally published spatial development strategy or alteration thereto). It is not the role of the CIL examination to challenge the soundness of an adopted development plan.' Item 18

The CLG guidance on CIL also states:

'Where infrastructure planning has been undertaken specifically for CIL and was not tested as part of another examination, the CIL examiner will only need to test that the evidence is **sufficient** in order to confirm the aggregate infrastructure funding gap and total target amount that the authority proposes to raise through CIL'. Item 17

Our approach to testing sufficiency is set out below.

## 2 Our approach

A robust infrastructure planning evidence base will have a sufficient number of projects, across a range of infrastructure categories that will lead to a substantial funding gap. Each individual project can be tested by looking at four elements:

- Need Is the project linked to growth?
- Project definition Is the defined project a reasonable response to the need?
- Cost Is the project cost robust
- Funding As the estimates of funding reasonable.

The adopted IDP covers Need, Project Definition and to some extent Cost; consequently the elements of infrastructure planning undertaken specifically for CIL in the case of Harrow are cost and funding and therefore we are focusing our work on those elements.

We have taken your IDP and imported it into our Infrastructure Planning Model. We use our model to conduct an analysis of the IDP that identifies:

- number of CIL eligble projects
- number of infrastructure categories and the cost contribution of each to the total cost
- · total cost of infrastructure over time
- amount of funding over time broken down by source
- aggregate funding gap

Using this information we can undertake targeted interrogation into projects, infrastructure categories or funding sources that are significantly contributing to the aggregate funding gap





## 3 Findings

#### 3.1 Base Information

This report is based upon the following base documents:

- Core Strategy Adopted Version February 2012 Infrastructure Schedule
- Infrastructure Assessment and Delivery Plan Working Document June 2012
- Capital Strategy Cabinet Paper of 9<sup>th</sup> February 2012

### 3.2 Information analysis

We've completed the analysis of the IDP over the plan period as follows:

- There a total of 226 projects from 12 infrastructure categories on the IDP list.
- 223 of the projects are CIL eligible
- 136 of the CIL eligible projects are costed.
- The total cost of these 136 costed projects (**Total Cost of Infrastructure**) is circa **£137m**.
- The significant contributors to the total cost are transport and education with 44% and 26% respectively.

The CIL Project Schedule, Summary Tables and Charts are contained in Appendices 1,2 and 3 respectively.

In all probably Harrow shall seek to review it's CIL Charging Schedule within a period of three to five years to keep it up to date with developing market conditions. We therefore suggest that the funding gap is demonstrated over a period of up to five years; also the period of time that Harrow are likely to have the most accurate estimates of funding.

Undertaking the same analysis over a five year period:

- There a total of 124 projects from 12 infrastructure categories on the IDP list.
- All of the projects are CIL eligible
- 124 of the CIL eligible projects are costed.
- The total cost of these 124 costed projects (Total Cost of Infrastructure) is circa £108m.
- The significant contributors are transport & education with 39% and 33% respectively.

#### 3.3 Targeted interrogation into projects

We've focused targeted interrogation on the infrastructure categories of transport and education. We have reviewed the available evidence and are satisfied that it is sufficient to support the need for the projects.

The outcomes of our detailed reviewed is contained within Appendix 4

#### 3.4 Funding from other sources

We have calculated the funding from other sources from the Capital Strategy Cabinet Paper of 9th February 2012 and the project specific funding identified within the Infrastructure Assessment and Delivery Plan Working Document – June 2012





Our findings can be articulated as follows:

- The total available funding over the period 2011-2015 is £47.1m
- Of the total 56.9% and 41.8% arise from external funding and capital reciepts respectively
- Only £640k of project specific funding has been identified.
- We have treated borrowing as funding of last resort and therefore it is not included.

#### In summary:

Total Cost of Infrastructure – Funding from other sources = Aggregate Funding Gap

£108.3m - £47.1m = £61.2m

The aggregate funding gap is £61.2m

### 3.5 Projected CIL Income

We used the housing trajectory supplied by Harrow to build a CIL income projection model. The model applies the proposed CIL rates to the housing trajectory and other variables set out below

# 3.6 Residual funding gap

Harrow requires a residual funding gap in order to charge CIL. The residual funding gap is calculated by deducting the projected CIL income from the aggregate funding gap.

Aggregate funding gap – Project CIL income = Residual funding gap £61.2m - £5.7m = c £55.5m

The residual funding gap is £55.5m and therefore Harrow are able to charge CIL.

### 4 Summary

Harrow are able to demonstrate a significant residual funding gap that is founded open an IDP that is part of the recently examined and adopted Core Strategy. This makes for a strong infrastructure planning evidence base in accordance with the CIL Regulations and therefore we would expect the CIL Examiner to find the evidence base sufficient.
