

Local Development Framework London Borough of Harrow Core Strategy Development Plan Document Adoption Statement – 16 February 2012

This Adoption Statement has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 24(4) and Regulation 36 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 and the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2008 and gives notice that the London Borough of Harrow resolved to formally adopt the Harrow Core Strategy Development Plan Document on the 16th February 2012.

The Core Strategy forms part of Harrow's Local Development Framework and will replace, in part, the Harrow Unitary Development Plan (2004) (as amended by the Secretary of States Direction of 27th September 2007). The Core Strategy is the principal document of the Local Development Framework and sets out the vision, spatial strategy and strategic policies for development in the Borough to 2026.

Mr Roland Punshon MRTPI, an independent Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government examined the document in a series of Hearings between the 27th September and 6th October 2011. The Inspector's Report, with its recommendations, was published on 13th December 2011. The adopted Core Strategy contains the Inspector's recommendations that are binding on the Council.

Any person aggrieved by the Core Strategy may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act (2004). Any challenge must be made on the grounds that either the document has not been prepared within the powers conferred by Part 2 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004, or that a procedural requirement of the Act or associated Regulations has not been complied with. Any such application must be made promptly and in any event no later than 6 weeks after the date of this statement (i.e. by the 29th March 2012).

The adopted Core Strategy, Inspector's Report, this Adoption Statement, the Sustainability Appraisal Report and the Sustainability Appraisal Adoption Statement (prepared in accordance with the Environmental Assessment of Plans and Programmes Regulations 2004 (16)(3) and (4) are available for public inspection on the Council's website, www.harrow.gov.uk/ldf and at the following locations:
