COUNTRY OF BIRTH OF HARROW'S RESIDENTS (DETAILED INFORMATION)

On 20th May 2013 the Office for National Statistics (ONS) released a detailed output table on Country of Birth. This is a Specially Commissioned Table (Table CT0048) which has been produced for the London Boroughs, at borough level only.

The results from this table confirm the cultural diversity of Harrow - the borough is ranked 7th nationally (and in London) for ethnic diversity and 2nd for religious diversity in London¹.

This detailed Country of Birth data is broadly comparable with Table CO413 from the 2001 Census (Appendix B), although the 2001 Census table had a lower threshold of ten people, whereas there is no lower threshold for the 2011 Census Table CT0048. However, in order to protect confidentiality in the 2011 Census the ONS has swapped some records in the Census database between different geographic areas (see Page 5). This means that, although there are no lower thresholds applied, all counts should be regarded as estimates only and therefore a definitive tally of the number of countries that Harrow's residents originate from is not precisely known. There are unlikely to be any cross-tabulations based on this very detailed country of birth information.

The original outputs on Country of Birth were released by the ONS on 11th December 2012 and were reported in Census Briefing Note 6. These two tables were less detailed than the newly released table, which gives Country of Birth by individual country. In order to consolidate all the Country of Birth information, at borough level in one place, the previously released tables have also been included in this Briefing Note, in Appendix A.

Key Results for Harrow

- The 2011 Census showed that Harrow's residents were born in approximately 203 different countries. In London as a whole approximately 247 different countries were recorded.
- 53.7 per cent (128,424) of Harrow's residents were born in England, the highest proportion. This ranks Harrow 27th in London (where 1st is the highest proportion).
- 55.2 per cent of Harrow's residents were born in the UK, the 6th lowest ranking nationally. In 2001 the corresponding percentage was 67 per cent.
- In 2011 Harrow's three largest migrant groups were those born in: India (21,539 people); Kenya (11,706); and Sri Lanka (10,392).
- Ten years ago in 2001, India was ranked 2nd (to England) for country of birth, with 12,411 residents. Kenya was 3rd with 10,259 residents and the Republic of Ireland was 4th with 6,090 residents.

- In 2011 there were 21 different foreign countries from which over 1,000 migrants have come from to live in Harrow, which compares to 13 countries in 2001
- 9 per cent (21,539) of Harrow's residents were born in India, the country's 4th largest Indian born community, after Leicester, Hounslow and Brent
- Harrow has London's (and England's) largest Kenyan born community, with 11,706 residents, Brent is 2nd with 7,382 residents. Harrow's Kenyan born residents are largely of Indian origin.
- Nationally Harrow has by far the highest number of residents who were born in Sri Lanka (10,392 residents), with Brent in 2nd place in London with 7,702 residents
- Harrow's Romanian born residents (4,784) form the country's largest community, based on the proportion of Romanian born residents to the overall population. However, in numerical terms Brent and Newham have higher numbers than Harrow.
- Harrow has London's 5th largest Irish born community in percentage terms (4,952). Nationally Harrow is ranked 7th, but there has been an 18.7 per cent fall in the number of Harrow residents born in Ireland since 2001.
- 2,241 (0.9%) of Harrow's residents were born in Somalia, ranking Harrow 14th nationally and forming London's 12th largest Somali community
- European Union (EU) Accession countries (April 2001 to March 2011) are the country of birth for 11,265 (4.7%) residents, the 18th highest ranking nationally and more than twice the national average of 2 per cent
- Other EU countries (including Ireland) are the birthplace of a further 4.7 per cent (11,130) of residents, twice the national average of 2.3 per cent
- 35.4 per cent (84,655) of residents were born elsewhere (outside the EU and the UK) - the 4th highest ranking nationally and nearly four times the national average of 9 per cent

Comparisons with 2001

Table 2 shows the top twenty countries of birth of Harrow's residents from the 2011 Census. It compares these countries of origin with the same countries of origin of Harrow's residents from the 2001 Census (Appendix B).

- In 2011, the top five ranked countries for country of birth were all ranked in the top five in the 2001 Census. However, Sri Lanka and Ireland have changed places over the decade, with Ireland dropping a rank and Sri Lanka going up one place.
- Countries ranked 6 to 12 in 2001 are still all ranked in the top twenty in 2011 for countries of birth
- Based on percentage change, the main changes since 2001 are the large increases in: the number of Romanian born residents (from 91 to 4,784); the number of Poles (from 506 to 3,868); the number of Afghans (from 1,021 to 3,314); and in the number of Nepalese (from 52 to 1,292)
- There were decreases in the number of residents born in England, Ireland, Scotland and Wales

Record swapping (by the ONS)

The individual records on the output database were slightly modified by random record swapping. This means that a sample of records was 'swapped' with similar records in other geographical areas. The proportion of records swapped was the same in all areas. No account was taken of the protection provided through differential data quality (differences in data quality between areas due to, e.g. different levels of non-response imputation). Information about the proportion of records swapped cannot be provided as this might compromise confidentiality protection.

Country of birth

Country of birth is the country in which a person was born. The country of birth question included six tick box responses - one for each of the four parts of the UK, one for the Republic of Ireland, and one for 'Elsewhere'. Where a person ticked 'Elsewhere', they were asked to write in the current name of the country in which they were born. Responses are assigned codes based on the National Statistics Country Classification.

The grouping of countries within the classification is broadly regional, but takes into account the grouping of European Union (EU) countries. Countries in the EU are grouped into those that were EU members in March 2001, and those that became members (Accession countries) between April 2001 and March 2011 as part of the EU enlargement process.

When a person's written response to the country of birth question was a former country name, and the country that it relates to no longer exists and is not wholly contained within the geographic boundary of a current country, the response was coded to one of the additional categories contained in the 'Former country' grouping. For example, 'Czechoslovakia' was coded to 'Czechoslovakia not otherwise specified'.

Ireland now includes people who ticked the Republic of Ireland and those who wrote in "Island of Ireland" or Ireland (plus Ulster which spans both north and south) Northern Ireland is those who recorded this ticked box.

Country of Birth (QS203EW) – Notes

Country of birth

Country of birth is the country in which a person was born. The country of birth question included six tick box responses - one for each of the four parts of the UK, one for the Republic of Ireland, and one for 'Elsewhere'. Where a person ticked 'Elsewhere', they were asked to write in the current name of the country in which they were born. Responses are assigned codes based on the National Statistics Country Classification.

The grouping of countries within the classification is broadly regional, but takes into account the grouping of European Union (EU) countries. Countries in the EU are grouped into those that were EU members in March 2001, and those that became members (Accession countries) between April 2001 and March 2011 as part of the EU enlargement process.

When a person's written response to the country of birth question was a former country name, and the country that it relates to no longer exists and is not wholly contained within the geographic boundary of a current country, the response was coded to one of the additional categories contained in the 'Former country' grouping. For example, 'Czechoslovakia' was coded to 'Czechoslovakia not otherwise specified'.

Ireland now includes people who ticked the Republic of Ireland and those who wrote in "Island of Ireland" or Ireland (plus Ulster which spans both north and south) Northern Ireland is those recorded this ticked box.
