Age is derived from the date of birth question and is a person's age at their last birthday. Dates of birth that imply an age over 115 are treated as invalid and the person's age is imputed. Infants less than one year old are classified as 0 years of age.

Mean age

Mean age is calculated by dividing the sum of each person's age by the number of people. Ages are the age at last birthday (in whole

Median age

The median age is the middle value when all the ages are arranged in order from youngest to oldest. Ages used are the age at last birthday

In 2011 the 'Aged 65 and over' and 'All aged 65 and over' variables were introduced replacing the 'Pensioner', 'All pensioners' and 'All pensioner' variables used in 2001. These only included males aged 65 and over and a females aged 60 and over and as a result direct comparisons between the two censuses is not possible for these

Married or same-sex civil partnership

In 2011 the 'Married or same-sex civil partnership' category was introduced replacing the 'Married couple households' category used in 2001. As a result direct comparisons between the two censuses is not possible.

Ethnic Group

Ethnic group classifies people according to their own perceived ethnic group and cultural background.

In 2011 two new categories were introduced: Gypsy or Irish traveller and Arab, therefore a comparison between 2001 and 2011 is not possible for these two categories.

Chinese has also been moved to come under the umbrella of Asian or Asian British rather than the 'Other' category.

To compare 2011 Census with 2001, White Gypsy or Irish traveller has been combined with White Other.

To compare 2011 Census with 2001, Arab has been combined with Any other ethnic group.

Country of birth

Country of birth is the country in which a person was born. The country of birth question included six tick box responses - one for each of the four parts of the UK, one for the Republic of Ireland, and one for 'Elsewhere'. Where a person ticked 'Elsewhere', they were asked to write in the current name of the country in which they were born. Responses are assigned codes based on the National Statistics Country Classification.

The grouping of countries within the classification is broadly regional, but takes into account the grouping of European Union (EU) countries. Countries in the EU are grouped into those that were EU members in March 2001, and those that became members (Accession countries) between April 2001 and March 2011 as part of the EU enlargement process.

When a person's written response to the country of birth question was a former country name, and the country that it relates to no longer exists and is not wholly contained within the geographic boundary of a current country, the response was coded to one of the additional categories contained in the 'Former country' grouping. For example, 'Czechoslovakia' was coded to 'Czechoslovakia not otherwise specified'.

Ireland now includes people who ticked the Republic of Ireland and those who wrote in "Island of Ireland" or Ireland (plus Ulster which spans both north and south) Northern Ireland is those who recorded this ticked box.

'2001 Census data for "Other countries" compares 2011 Census Other EU: Accession countries, UK not otherwise specified and Other countries.
