Aims

The forum aims to:

- Establish a network of supplementary schools.
- Provide opportunities to exchange experience, share resources, learn from each other and support each other.
- Promote understanding and partnerships between mainstream schools and supplementary schools.
- Invite presentations from different professionals.
- Represent the voice of Harrow supplementary schools to engage with Harrow Council and other local and national bodies.
- Facilitate partnerships between HSSF and other voluntary organisations to attract funding.
- Identify relevant training opportunities to develop the effectiveness of supplementary schools in Harrow e.g. safeguarding.
- Promote the NRCSE Quality Mark for Supplementary schools.
- Enhance the status of Supplementary Schools in Harrow through the above.
- Represent established diverse communities.

Membership

- Membership is open to all schools delivering supplementary education in Harrow.

Participation

All forum members are expected to:

- Be active participants in the development of the forum through regular attendance of forum meetings
- Share their own good practice and be willing to learn from others
- Promote the forum and its work to all members of their organisation
- Commit to a quality assurance scheme such as the Quality Mark to increase the impact of the forum
- It is recommended that all schools register with the National Resource Centre for Supplementary Education (NRCSE).
- **To be eligible for funding Supplementary Schools need to have completed or are working towards the Quality Mark.**
