Carer and toddler groups are also known as baby and toddler groups, parent and toddler groups or stay and play sessions and are usually based in the community. These are informal settings where parents/carers, grandparents, nannies/au-pairs, childminders and their children can go to have fun, and for parents to get to know other families.

Most groups are open at regular times each week (term time only) for between one and two hours.

Registration

Carer and toddler groups are not required to register with Ofsted (Office for Standards in Education, Children's Services and Skills) under the Childcare Act 2006; or follow the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) statutory framework. Parents/carers who attend remain with their children throughout the session and are responsible for their care at all times.

Who organises Carer and Toddler Groups?

Some groups are run by a committee of parents who share the responsibility for its organisation. With most groups, a group of volunteers, usually parents attending the group, take on the responsibility of its running and management.

Some groups may be privately run and managed or be part of the services offered within your local children's centre – you can find more information on Harrow children's centre website www.childrenatthecentre.org.uk.

Every group is different and it may take a few visits before you get to know the group and feel part of it. Sometimes the best way to get to know people is to get involved and offer to help.

If there is not a carer and toddler group in your area and you would like to help to establish one, please contact the Pre-school Learning Alliance on 020 8905 0374, who will be able to advise you on the procedure.

What happens at a Parent and Toddler Group?

Although this will vary from group to group, most will provide opportunities for:

- babies to play and explore in a safe area
- free play with a good range of toys including larger equipment
- a craft activity that may involve cutting, sticking or painting
- singing time often at the end of a session to allow for clearing away of toys
- a refreshment break for adults and children

Ages catered for

The age range can vary but is usually from birth to 3 or up to school age but most groups also welcome expectant mums.

How much do they cost?

Most groups charge per session – this may include refreshments and craft materials

There are many advantages in attending a carer and toddler group?

• it allows your child(ren) to socialise with other children and gives the opportunity for parents/carers to meet others, and so avoid the isolation that looking after children often involves

- it provides the opportunity for child(ren) to play with new toys and join in new fun activities
- parents/carers can meet people who are in similar situations and so find support and meet friends
- sometimes professionals such as childcare workers drop in for advice and support, discuss specific topics and answer any concerns or queries you may have

What to look for when choosing a carer and toddler group?

- make sure that you will be able to attend the group regularly during the times that it runs and that it is easily accessible to you whether you are walking, driving or taking public transport.
- ❖ visit when the group is open, ask the person leading the group about the hours, price, and age range and if the group has a waiting list or operates a drop-in session.
- the group should have a welcome letter/pack giving information about the group to new parents/carers once they have registered and the leader may be able to introduce you to other families with children of a similar age.
- if you have a young baby check that the group has a separate area for babies to ensure their safety
- check that the premises are clean, well kept and safe for the children and that all the toys are clean and appropriate for the age of the children using the group.
- ❖ ask about the activities available for your child. A good carer and toddler group should have a range of fun activities for the children, including messy play, construction, imaginative play and creative play, etc.
- ❖ ask about the routine of the group. Most groups have a free play time, a snack time and usually end with a music or singing session.
- ❖ if there are other things you need to know don't be afraid to ask, the leaders of the groups will be happy to answer them.
