Ofsted holds two registers for childcare providers. These are the Early Years Register and the Childcare Register, which has a compulsory and a voluntary part.

Most childminders care for children aged from birth to five years and are registered on the Early Years Register. They have to meet the welfare, learning and development requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). The EYFS is a statutory framework that sets standards to enable early years providers to deliver individualised learning, development and care that enhances the development of the children in their care, and gives those children the best possible start in life. The EYFS is divided into four themes: a unique child, positive relationships, enabling environments and learning and development. You can discuss this framework further with your childminder to find out how it works within their provision.

If the childminder cares for children aged five to under eight years they will be registered on the compulsory part of the Childcare Register and have to meet its requirements. Childminders caring for children over eight can choose to be registered on the voluntary part of the Childcare Register and meet its requirements. #### Ofsted reports

Inspections are carried out with little or no notice to evaluate the quality and standards of the provision and to check that the childminder is continuing to meet their registration requirements and any conditions imposed. It is a parent/carers right to ask to see the latest Ofsted inspection report or visit the Ofsted website for a copy of the report. To find the report on the website you will require the childminders' unique reference number, which can be obtained from the childminder.

Newly registered childminders do not have reports available but to get their certificate, they must meet the national standards for childminding.

#### It is illegal for an unregistered person to look after children under 8 years for reward.

Registered childminders, both male and female, work in all parts of the borough of Harrow. Childminders are self-employed and set their own terms, hours and conditions. These arrangements form the basis of a <u>contract</u>, which is between the childminder and the parent/carer.

Ofsted will inspect a random selection of all those on the Childcare Register and will always inspect if a complaint is received that relates to the requirements of registration.

#### **Quality Assurance**

All childminders are required to have completed Unit 1 of the Diploma in Home-based Childcare and maintain a current Paediatric First Aid certificate.

Childminders have the opportunity to undertake quality assurance either as part of a Children Come First Network or on an individual basis with the Quality First scheme. Harrow has a National Childminders Association approved Children Come First Network and a number of childminders who have completed Quality First accreditation.

#### Choosing a childminder

- Childminders look after children in the childminder's own home and can offer flexible hours.
- Always ask to see a childminder's Ofsted registration certificate, as this will show any restrictions to the registration, then <u>check</u> with the Families Information Service that the childminder is still registered.
- We advise that you check that your childminder has taken out public liability insurance cover.
- Childminders must plan and organise their day to ensure that every child receives an enjoyable, challenging, learning and development experience that meets their individual needs. Ask the childminder which parks, playgrounds, toy libraries and activity sessions they will be using.
- It is important that you take time to choose a childminder who will best suit the needs of your child/children.

#### How do I know my child will be safe and secure?

First of all you know your child best – look for a childminder you feel will be suitable for your child. Regular inspections by Ofsted mean that checks are carried out to ensure that childminders are suitable to care for children and that the home environment is safe and secure. All adults over 16, living or working in the childminder's household should have undergone a criminal records check (CRB).

#### How many children will there be with a childminder?

Registered childminders can care for up to six children under eight years of age; of these no more than three must be aged under five, at any one time. They are limited to one baby under 12 months old except in specific circumstances.

This number includes the childminder's own children and any others for whom they are responsible and who are on the premises. However the number of children they can care for as stated on their Ofsted certificate does not include their own children. Childminders who work with an assistant may look after larger groups of children depending on space available and subject to planning permission. Childminders may also look after older children before and after school and during the school holidays.

#### How old does my child need to be?

Children can go to a childminder from a few months old until care is no longer required, although childminders only need to be registered to care for children aged under eight years.

#### What hours do childminders work?

Childminders are self-employed and decide on their working hours. Most childminders work between the hours of 8am to 6pm. Some childminders will work early mornings, evenings and weekends as well. Childminders can register to care for children overnight, meeting specific requirements to keep children safe and secure. If a childminder has registered to care for children overnight it will say so on their certificate. You will need to negotiate hours, terms and conditions with the childminder.

#### What about part-time childcare?

Some childminders provide families with part-time childcare. They often take children to school and collect them. Childminders can also take your child to a playgroup or pre-school as part of the routine.

#### **Contract**

We strongly advise that contracts should be in writing and signed by both parties, prior to the child/children starting. The signed contract should contain terms and conditions on rates of pay, holiday pay, sick pay, who will provide meals, hours of attendance, review date of contract, period of notice to be given.

- This arrangement is strictly between the childminder and parent; and it is legally binding.
- Later changes to the contract must be signed and dated by both of parties and each must keep a signed copy.
- If you do not have a signed contract you will have nothing to support you if you feel that the arrangement is not turning out as you expected. Call the National Childminding Association on 0800 169 4486 if you have questions about contracts.

#### How much does a childminder cost?

Childminders set their own fees and are usually paid on an hourly rate; there is no national rate of pay.

#### Factors to be considered:

Do they charge hourly, daily or weekly?

Do they charge for overtime, unsociable hours or absences?

What are the arrangements for holiday pay for the childminder and the child's absence due to holidays or sickness?

#### What to look for when choosing a childminder?

Here are some suggested questions to ask and things to look for when you visit. You may want to add your own as well.

- How long they have been working with children?
- How do you settle in new children?
- Does the hygiene of the home meet with your standards?
- Do you have a garden, is the fence and gates secure?
- Is the play equipment safe, suitable, clean and in good condition?
- Where will my child rest?
- What activities do you do with the children?
- What outings do you go on?
- Do you take the children out in the car and if so do you have suitable insurance cover, seat belts and car seats for this?
- How do you manage behaviour?
- Will my children be with a regular group of children, how old are they and how does their timetable fit in with my child?
- Is the routine of the day flexible to meet individual needs?
- How will I be informed of my child's progress?
- Are the children calm, safe and happy?
- Does the childminder listen to the children and respond to what they are saying?

If there are other things you want to know do not be afraid to ask. Childminders expect you to ask questions and will be happy to answer them.

Always take up references. You could ask for names of other parents/carers to talk to about your chosen childminder.

Listen to your child and find out more if s/he seems unhappy. Always trust your own feelings about your childcare – you know your child best.

#### Remember to sign an agreed contract prior to your child/children starting.

#### Help with your childcare costs

#### Tax credits

You can claim Working Tax Credit if you and the partner you live with are working at least 16 hours per week. For further information contact the Inland Revenue on **0345 300 3900** for a claim pack or visit their website <u>www.hmrc.gov.uk</u>.

#### Child Tax Credit

You can claim Child Tax Credit if you are responsible for one child (or young person) or more. You do not have to be working to claim. Child Tax Credit will be paid in addition to Child Benefit and any Working Tax Credit. #### **Nursery Education Grant (NEF)**

All 3 and 4 year olds in Harrow have access to a free, good quality, part-time early education place. For 3 year olds this entitlement starts from the term following their third birthday, and all 4 year old children who attend a registered provider located in Harrow will be entitled to a free nursery education place for **three** terms before they reach statutory school age (the term after the child's fifth birthday) regardless of the location of the child's place of residence.
