Title of document

Harrow School Planning Document (SPD)

Subject matter

On 4th July 2013 Harrow Council adopted a Site Allocations development plan document for the London Borough of Harrow. This document allocated Harrow School (allocation G01) to establish the principle of the refurbishment / redevelopment of school buildings and the enhancement of sports facilities. The Council has prepared a draft document pursuant to Regulation 5(1)(a)(iii) to supplement allocation G01 which outlines how the School proposes to redevelop its estate over the next 20 years including guidance on design, and the enhancement of open space and heritage assets. The draft document is the Harrow School Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) and, if adopted, will provide a masterplan for the School Estates future development.

Area covered

The SPD will, if adopted, apply to the ward of Harrow on the Hill

Period within which representations must be made

Representations can be made over the five week public participation period, beginning on Monday 30th March and ending 5pm on Friday 1st May 2015.
