
## 25. WEST TOWERS CONSERVATION AREA, PINNER.

Confirmed by the Secretary of State for the Environment 10th June 1991.

Classes of permitted development controlled (made under the 1988 General Development Order):

## Schedule II

Part 1 Class A: The enlargement, improvement or alteration of a dwellinghouse.

Class D: The erection or construction of a porch outside any external door

of a dwellinghouse of any property.

Class H: The installation, alteration or replacement of a microwave

antenna on a dwellinghouse or within the curtilage of a

dwellinghouse

only on front & exposed side elevations

Part 2 Class C: The painting of the exterior of any building or work. (In relation to the exterior

brickwork areas on the front and flank elevations of all properties within the CA).

Confirmed by the Secretary of State on 23rd October 2003.

Classes of permitted development controlled (made under the 1995 General Permitted Development Order):

**Part 1 Class C:** Any other alteration to the roof of a dwellinghouse (such as the insertion of rooflights or the alteration of roof tiles).
