a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 9)

The event is managed and guided by a Steering Group. The steering group responsible for organising the event; there will be over twnty staff members and volunteers from current team and also over 40 new vlunteers involved in managing the event and also providing support the attendees; the Steering Group make sure that all necessory steps are taken to ensure that a safe event is provided including:

- The local SNT is informed and aware of upcoming event; all action plans including emergency plans are agreed;
- An agreement with a private security company signed;
- 40 or more volunteers are recruited, vetted and inducted:
- The first aid team and named safeguarding person are recruited;
- Full risk assessment is conducted;
- All measures are taken to prevent any crime;

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

The Steering Group will make sure the local safer neighbourhood team is aware of the event and a joint prevention plan is agreed; we also make sure that the private security company is fully inducted and aware event activities;

The security team will be responsible for communicating with local Police and preventing any crime; additionally, the volunteer coordinator will induct a team of up to 40 volunteers about the appropriate action to be taken in case of suspecious activities. Any suspecious activity will be report immdiately to the Police.

c) Public safety

Public safety is our main priority; a team of up to 40 volunteer-stewards will help people to get access to the appropriate activities or services; clear signs will be provided for each activity and the fire exit, the first aid team will be located by the event information point; there will clear notes for the public on how to act in the event of emergency or for example what to do when a clid is missing. A full risk assessment of the area is attached..

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The one day festival is a day event; public will have access to the venue from 11am to 7pm; we make sure that all activities are run within the venue and no disturbance is caused to the local neighbourhood; a large number of staff and volunteers will look making sure the young people and other attendees respect the local neighbourhood.

e) The protection of children from harm

A named safeguarding person for the event will be in the area all day during the event time named safeguarding person will be known to all volunteers, staff members and security geteam; the name person will work closely with local Social Services and the Police to address any child protection issue.	uard
