The premises operates as banqueting venue. All events are pre-booked and the numbers are agreed. These events are mainly family celebrations. The premises has been in operation for more than 20 years and long standing staff managing the premises. The variation is only looking for 1 hour increase on Friday and Saturdays with longer and gradual dispersal times, which has been argued for in the Licensing Act 2003. Due to this nature of operation, there is no adverse impact on the licensing objectives.
b) The prevention of crime and disorder
On Days (Friday and Saturday nights) where a part booking is taken beyond 0100, SIA registered staff will be employed at a ratio of 1:100.
c) Public safety
As above
d) The prevention of public nuisance
As above
e) The protection of children from harm
The premises have a very strict and exceptionally robust system of dealing with underage sales/consumption. All bookings
