Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

If the club wishes members and their guests to be able to consume alcohol on the premises select on, if the club wishes people to be able to purchase alcohol to consume away from the premises select off. If the club wishes people to be able to do both select both.

Strong management controls and effective training of all staff so that they are aware of premises license and the requirements to meet the four licensing objectives with the particular attention to no underage drinking or supply of alcohol to underage people both for on and off sales, drunk and disorderly behavior on the premises and when leaving, vigilance in preventing the use and sale of illegal drugs, violent and antisocial behavior and ensuring no harm to children.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Management and staff trained and informed of premises license, use of proof of ID cards where customers are or appear to be underage. No serving of alcohol to unruly or intoxicated customers. Staff trained in asking customers to leave premises in orderly and respectful manner. We have active CCTV's in action inside the premises and outside.

c) Public safety

Use and training of use of fire safety equipment and evacuation procedures, regular testing of all electrical equipment and fire safety equipment. Training and implementation of underage ID checks. A member of the management team will be on the premises all the time the store is is open and will and will be trained to manage the store including looking after the safety of the public.

The store will adhere to all rules and regulations relating to public safety.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

The store intends to be active member of the community.

We will be happy to liaise with police enforcement authorities should the need arise.

Implementing and use of customer complaint book. Staff are trained in taking complaints from customers and local resident complains.

We have double glazed doors and windows which are closed at all times and we plant signs and trained our staff to ask people to leave premises quietly and in a respectful manner.

e) The protection of children from harm

Training and use of ID cards to customers who are or appear to be under 18 years of age.

All staff will be trained will be trained and regularly refreshed in the corporate 'Think 25' policy. Staff will be trained to look at the customer and 'Think 25' when selling restricted products.

The store will display sign age around the premises informing both staff and customers of our 'Think 25' policy.

A till prompt will appear on the initial sale of alcohol that will remind the seller of the 'Think 25' policy and remind staff not to sell alcohol to anyone under
