## c) Public safety

Pre opening checks will be carried out prior to opening to ensure that all entrances / exits are clear

Safety checks are to be carried out before the admission of the public.

Safety checks are to be recorded in a Log Book held on the premises.

Adequate and appropriate first aid equipment and materials are to be made available at the premises at all times. The CCTV will be checked daily

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

Dedicated taxi numbers will be available to customers

A written dispersal policy will be in place

Clear signage is to be displayed prominently and maintained at all exits of the premises requiring patrons to leave and enter the premises and area quietly out of respect for local residents.

Refuse, including bottles, is to be taken and placed into receptacles outside the premises at times which will minimise the disturbance to nearby premises.

Notices must be prominently displayed at the exits reminding patrons to depart in an orderly manner

## e) The protection of children from harm

No children allowed in the bar unless accompanied by an adult

No children allowed in the bar after 2100

Any refusals to sell to young persons shall be noted

The premises shall ensure that all staff are trained about age restricted products and training logged and signed by the staff to confirm that they understood

\*If the premises rateable value is in Bands D or E and the premises is primarily used for the consumption of alcohol on the premises then your are required to pay a higher fee

Band D - £87001 to £12500 £900.00 Band E - £125001 and over £1,905.00

There is an exemption from the payment of fees in relation to the provision of regulated entertainment at church halls, chapel halls or premises of a similar nature, village halls, parish or community halls, or other premises of a similar nature. The costs associated with these licences will be met by central Government. If, however, the licence also authorises the use of the premises for the supply of alcohol or the provision of late night refreshment, a fee will be required.

Schools and sixth form colleges are exempt from the fees associated with the authorisation of regulated entertainment where the entertainment is provided by and at the school or college and for the purposes of the school or college.
