There is an exemption from the payment of fees in relation to the provision of regulated entertainment at church halls, chapel halls or premises of a similar nature, village halls, parish or community halls, or other premises of a similar nature. The costs associated with these licences will be met by central Government. If, however, the licence also authorises the use of the premises for the supply of alcohol or the provision of late night refreshment, a fee will be required.

Schools and sixth form colleges are exempt from the fees associated with the authorisation of regulated entertainment where the entertainment is provided by and at the school or college and for the purposes of the school or college.

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

Re: Application under the Licensing Act 2003, The Candy Shop, 188 Station Road, Harrow, Middlesex, HA1 2RH

The authority has received your application for a premises licence in relation to the above premises. The application has not been accepted and therefore is being returned for the followings reasons:

- 1. The fee submitted was incorrect.
- According to the Valuation Office (VOA) the Non-Domestic Rateable Value for the premises should is £6900.00 therefore you are in band B and the fee will be £190.00. Please refer to Section 2.
- 3. We require details of all applicants, you have selected that you are in a partnership therefore we need the details for your partner to check the insolvency register as well as add them to the licence. Please refer to Section 3 and 4.
- 4. In Section 5 you indicated you wanted a timed premises licence, could you please give further details why you would only need the licence for the time specified?
- 5. In Section 5 you also need to provide a general description. The nature of the business.
- 6. In Section 15 you have not given the personal licence number of the DPS.
- 7. You have also not supplied a DPS consent with the application.
- 8. In Section 18 you need to complete in full how you intend to take to promote each of the four licensing objectives.
- 9. The plan that you have submitted do not comply with regulations.
- 10. In your declaration you also need to add the signature of your partner.

Only when these matters have been addressed and the application returned, can the process continue. Please note that the consultation period has not started; there is no need to advertise at this stage.

In the meantime, I must warn you that the making of an application does not in itself confer any authority to undertake licensable activities. If you undertake any licensable activities without a valid licence, you make yourself liable to prosecution. The penalty on conviction is a fine and a term of imprisonment of up to six months.

You are only required to advertise your application when this Authority has accepted it as valid.
