Describe briefly the nature of the proposed variation
The applicants premises is an Italian Restaurant located in The Broadway of Hatch End. The proposed variation is to extend the existing licensable activities namely the retail sale of alcohol, late night refreshment, recorded music Sunday to Thursdays inclusive until 01:00 the next day and on Friday and Saturdays until 01:30 the next day.
To add to the licence the provision of live music, making music and performance of dance Sunday to Thursdays inclusive until 01:00 the next day and on Friday and Saturdays until 01:30 the next day. To add a closing time of 30 minutes after the end of licensable activities.
The reason for the variation is so that the applicant can provide Elvis and or other cabaret type evenings alongside existing licensable activities to restaurant patrons taking a table meal from the food and beverage menu as part of the Dona Theresa restaurant experience. The applicant has in the past applied for a series of temporary event notices and would like to extend the licence on a permanent basis.
The applicant via his agent and in conjunction with the Secretary of States Revised Guidance issued under section 182 of the Licensing Act 2003 and Harrow Councils Statement of Licensing Policy 2010 have developed a risk assessment to help to identify, minimize and where possible mitigate risks and issues that may arise from extended and new licensable activities and associated timings. The findings of the risk assessment have been applied to formulate a set of specific licensing conditions as part of the operating schedule as set out in section 18 of this application to show what arrangements will be put in place to promote the 4 licensing objectives.
