PC Downes on behalf of the Metropolitan Police Service has applied to HARROW COUNCIL as THE LICENSING AUTHORITY for a REVIEW OF THE PREMISES LICENCE on the grounds of Prevention of Crime and Disorder in respect of:

Express Food and Wine, 21 High Street, Wealdstone, HA3 5BY

Anyone wishing to make representations about the review must give notice in writing to the Head of Public Protection, London Borough of Harrow, Civic Centre, P O Box 18, Station Road, Harrow, Middlesex, HA1 2UT, by Friday 26 April 2019, specifying their grounds for doing so. Note also that any petitions must follow certain rules.

Copies of those objections will initially be sent to the Premises Licence Holder for their consideration. Persons objecting to the grant of licences must be prepared to attend in person at a public hearing before a committee of the Council.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is £5000
