Anyone wishing to join the application for review must give notice in writing to the Head of Community Safety Services, London Borough of Harrow, Civic Centre, P O Box 18, Station Road, Harrow, Middlesex, HA1 2UT, WITHIN 28 DAYS shown at the top of this notice, specifying the grounds of objection. Note also that any petitions must follow certain rules.

Copies of those objections will initially be sent to the applicant for their consideration. Persons objecting to the grant of licences must be prepared to attend in person at a public hearing before a committee of the Council.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly to make a false statement in connection with an application and the maximum fine for which a person is liable on summary conviction for the offence is £5000
