- 1. The consumption of beverages in external areas of the premises shall cease after 23:30
- 2. The maximum number of patrons accommodated at any one time should not exceed

350

- 3. While amplified music is played, the inner set of doors to both front entrances are to be kept shut after 20:00.
- 4. The premises licence holder and premises supervisor will ensure that except in the case of accident or emergency a personal licence holder will be available at the premises from 18:00 until the end of licensable activities on Thursday, Fridays, and Saturdays.
- 5. There will be no entertainments of an adult or nude nature at the premises.
- 6. The premises licence holder or premises supervisor or in their absence a member of senior management who is a personal licence holder shall attend PubWatch meetings as appropriate for the area in which the premises are situate.
- 7. No empty bottles to be disposed of until after 10:00am the following morning.
- 8. A digital CCTV system shall be installed and maintained at the premises to meet the reasonable requirements of police within 28 days of such date when the premises licence is transferred to the premises licence holder.
- 9. A 'Challenge 21' policy will be operated at the premises, whereby any person
- attempting to purchase alcohol (or other age restricted products) and who appears to be under the age of 21 years, will be asked to provide proof (i.e. passport, driver's licence or some other such accredited form of photo identification) that they over the age of 18 years. Notices will be displayed advising customers that the scheme is in operation. A record of age related refusals of sale will be kept and will be made available to officers of the police or local authority upon request.
- 10. An alarm system shall be installed and maintained at the premises.
- 11. Any amusement with prizes machines in use at the premises will be fitted with a security device acceptable to police and such machines will be emptied at night.
- 12. Appropriate automatic noise control device must be fitted to all amplified soun

equipment. The device must be:

a) Set so that the volume of any amplified sound emanating from the premises does not cause a public nuisance. A Compliance Certificate must be supplied to the licensing authority for the installation of the unit for approval before any regulated entertainment is carried out.

The installation must be carried out by a competent/qualified person. The compliance certificate must contain the following.

5 minute LAEQ Frequency analysis between 200Hz down to 30Hz The Premises Supervisor must ensure that any amplified sound from the premises does not cause a public nuisance by ensuring that amplified sound is inaudible at the boundary of any premises where the occupiers are likely to be affected by noise.

- 13. No customers will be permitted in the rear garden area after 23:00
- 14: Access to the rear garden area from the double doors in the sports bar area will not be permitted after 21:00 hours except in emergencies. Such access will be available from the doors in the toilet lobby area.
- 15. After midnight on Thursday, Friday and Saturday there shall be at least 2 security officers in high visibility jackets in the external area of the premises to help disperse customers quickly and quietly.
- 16. All fire exit doors to the premises shall be shut at all times except in case of emergency.
- 17. The premises licence holder and premises supervisor will ensure that staff are trained in respect of relevant licensing laws and compliance with conditions attached to the premises licence and any internal policies of the premises. A written record of all training provided to staff shall be maintained setting out the names of those who received training, the subjects they were trained on, and the date on which they were trained. This record of training shall be made available to officers of the licensing authority on request.
- 18. To preclude the admission of new customers after 12 midnight on Thursdays and Sundays and after 0:30 hours on Fridays and Saturdays. The premises shall operate a verifiable system to control persons re-entering the premises.

- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;

- any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
- o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
- any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
- 3. Where taking place in a building or other structure please tick as appropriate (indoors may include a tent).

- 12. An applicant's agent (for example solicitor) may sign the form on their behalf provided that they have actual authority to do so.
- 13. Where there is more than one applicant, each of the applicants or their respective agent must sign the application form.

15. Entitlement to work/immigration status for individual applicants and applications from partnerships which are not limited liability partnerships:

A licence may not be held by an individual or an individual in a partnership who is resident in the UK who:

- does not have the right to live and work in the UK; or
- is subject to a condition preventing him or her from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity.

Any premises licence issued in respect of an application made on or after 6 April 2017 will become invalid if the holder ceases to be entitled to work in the UK.

Applicants must demonstrate that they have an entitlement to work in the UK and are not subject to a condition preventing them from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity. - A certificate of registration or naturalisation as a British citizen, when produced in
 combination with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance
 number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A current passport endorsed to show that the holder is allowed to stay in the UK and is
 currently allowed to work and is not subject to a condition preventing the holder from
 doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity.
- A **current** Biometric Immigration Document (Biometric Residence Permit) issued by the Home Office to the holder which indicates that the named person can currently stay in the UK and is allowed to work relation to the carrying on of a licensable activity.

- A **current** Residence Card issued by the Home Office to a person who is not a national of a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a national or who has derivative rights or residence.
- A current Immigration Status Document containing a photograph issued by the Home Office to the holder with an endorsement indicating that the named person may stay in the UK, and is allowed to work and is not subject to a condition preventing the holder from doing work relating to the carrying on of a licensable activity when produced in combination with an official document giving the person's permanent National Insurance number and their name issued by a Government agency or a previous employer.
- A Certificate of Application, **less than 6 months old**, issued by the Home Office under regulation 17(3) or 18A (2) of the Immigration (European Economic Area) Regulations 2006, to a person who is not a national of a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a national or who has derivative rights of residence.
- Reasonable evidence that the person has an outstanding application to vary their
 permission to be in the UK with the Home Office such as the Home Office
 acknowledgement letter or proof of postage evidence, or reasonable evidence that the
 person has an appeal or administrative review pending on an immigration decision, such
 as an appeal or administrative review reference number.
- Reasonable evidence that a person who is not a national of a European Economic Area state or Switzerland but who is a family member of such a national or who has derivative rights of residence in exercising treaty rights in the UK including:-
 - evidence of the applicant's own identity such as a passport,
 - evidence of their relationship with the European Economic Area family member e.g. a marriage certificate, civil partnership certificate or birth certificate, and
 - evidence that the European Economic Area national has a right of permanent residence in the UK or is one of the following if they have been in the UK for more than 3 months:
 - (i) working e.g. employment contract, wage slips, letter from the employer,
 - (ii) self-employed e.g. contracts, invoices, or audited accounts with a bank,
 - (iii) studying e.g. letter from the school, college or university and evidence of sufficient funds; or
 - (iv) self-sufficient e.g. bank statements.

Family members of European Economic Area nationals who are studying or financially independent must also provide evidence that the European Economic Area national and any family members hold comprehensive sickness insurance in the UK. This can include a private medical insurance policy, an EHIC card or an S1, S2 or S3 form.

Original documents must not be sent to licensing authorities. If the document copied is a passport, a copy of the following pages should be provided:-

- (i) any page containing the holder's personal details including nationality;
- (ii) any page containing the holder's photograph;
- (iii) any page containing the holder's signature;
- (iv) any page containing the date of expiry; and
- (v) any page containing information indicating the holder has permission to enter or remain in the UK and is permitted to work.

If the document is not a passport, a copy of the whole document should be provided.

Your right to work will be checked as part of your licensing application and this could involve us checking your immigration status with the Home Office. We may otherwise share information with the Home Office. Your licence application will not be determined until you have complied with this guidance.
