Please describe briefly the nature of the proposed variation (please read guidance note 1)

The proposed variation is to approve the layout plan deposited with the Licensing Authority, drawing number 14/399/100, as the licensing plan. This plan shows the correct layout of the premises.

All existing licensable activities extend to the internal areas outlined in red.

Further, the application seeks to license the external areas of the premises as shown on the deposited plan, principally so that table service can be provided including the sale of alcohol. Accordingly, the variation seeks to license the external areas outlined in red for sale by retail of alcohol and late night refreshment only.

No amendments are proposed to the general method of operation of the premises or the operating hours and accordingly Boxes A – H have not been completed. Boxes I and J have been completed with regard to the external use.

It is not considered that the internal layout identified on the deposited plan adversely affects the four licensing objectives as it reflects the current layout at the premises. In addition, it is not anticipated that the inclusion of the external areas within the licensed area will adversely affect the licensing objectives. The remaining licence conditions will continue to apply and are assessed to be sufficient for the proposals. The operating schedule has been completed on that basis.

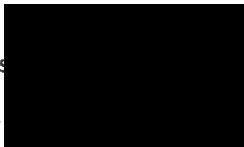
