This premises has had many Temporary Event Notices until 0400 during Thursdays to Sundays for the last 5 years or more and had not attracted a single hearing relating to those Temporary Notices. The management has fine tuned it's dispersal arrangements during these late openings and now in a position to apply for a later time of 0200 on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturday nights and to 0030 until Sundays. The Management already supply security to monitor the Sainsbury car-Park, which is used by some of the clients of Spicerack along with all other venues in this area, however Spicerack is the only venue further to residents' request provides security staff to monitor this car park on busy periods until Spicerack is closed. This practice now will be extended to cover the new opening times. The proposed Variation is to increase the Licensable activities on Thursdays to Saturdays by hour and a half with a 30 min drinking up time. The premises has been operating very successfully promoting all 4 of the Licensing Objectives since opened. The premises has had many late night openings up to 4am authorised by Temporary event notices with out undermining the Licensing Objectives. The existing operating schedule provides adequate and appropriate controls for this variation so that Licensing Objectives are not undermined. We have provided certain additional assessments to reflect this application.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

a minimum of 4 SIA registered security will be on duty on Thursday to Saturdays when there are organised events and an expected capacity of more than 150 persons.

c) Public safety

During dispersal on Thursdays to Saturdays, a SIA staff will attend the outside to make sure a safe dispersal is facilitated.

d) The prevention of public nuisance
