

The premises is a Restaurant/Bar with Regulated entertainment facilities. Currently licensed until midnight on week days and until 2330 on Sundays. This premises has had many Temporary Event Notices until 0400 during Thursdays to Sundays for the last 5 years or more and had not attracted a single hearing relating to those Temporary Notices. The management has fine tuned it's dispersal arrangements during these late openings and now in a position to apply for a later time of 0200 on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturday nights and to 0030 until Sundays. The Management already supply security to monitor the Sainsbury car-Park, which is used by some of the clients of Spicerack along with all other venues in this area, however Spicerack is the only venue further to residents' request provides security staff to monitor this car park on busy periods until Spicerack is closed. This practice now will be extended to cover the new opening times. The proposed Variation is to increase the Licensable activities on Thursdays to Saturdays by hour and a half with a 30 min drinking up time. To extend the Licensable activities on Sundays by 30 minutes with an additional 30 min to close for public.
