

d) The prevention of public nuisance

Prominent, clear and legible notices shall be displayed at the entrance/exit requesting the public to respect the needs of local residents and to leave the premises and the area quietly.

e) The protection of children from harm

As per Mandatory Conditions – The Licensing Act 2003 (Mandatory Licensing Conditions) (Amendment) Order 2014 the age verification policy shall apply to persons who appear to be under the age of 21 years old ("Challenge 21 policy"). A record of age related refusals of sale will be kept and will be made available to officers of the police or local authority immediately upon request.

There is an exemption from the payment of fees in relation to the provision of regulated entertainment at church halls, chapel halls or premises of a similar nature, village halls, parish or community halls, or other premises of a similar nature. The costs associated with these licences will be met by central Government. If, however, the licence also authorises the use of the premises for the supply of alcohol or the provision of late night refreshment, a fee will be required.

Schools and sixth form colleges are exempt from the fees associated with the authorisation of regulated entertainment where the entertainment is provided by and at the school or college and for the purposes of the school or college.
