Allow customers to use the phone when and if necessary to call a cab if not provide local cab numbers. Be vigilante and on the look out for any potential issue(s) and resolve them amicably.

#### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Inform the local police of any issue or potential issue as when it arises. Use literature such as fliers provided by community support officers to make all customers aware that we will cooperate and assist in every way possible with the Police in order to prevent any crime or disorder.

# c) Public safety

Provide any literature available from the Police and Community Support and comply any recommendations that they give. Be ready and willing to assist members of the public as and when needed. Train staff at the Restaurant to ensure that they are aware of how to deal with any situation and who they need to contact if a situation arises.

# d) The prevention of public nuisance

Put up notices and also speak to people to ask them to keep noise levels down, especially groups of people. Where possible try and assist customers to get on their way by calling cabs or allowing customers to use the phone to call a cab or a lift.

### e) The protection of children from harm

Take extra care to look out for children who visit the restaurant and ensure that they are not left unattended in the Premises.
