The standard practices listed below will be maintained at all times. All reasonable steps will be taken to ensure that the premises will have a positive impact upon the local environment and its resident at all times.

### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- -A CCTV system is already installed inside and another CCTV system to be installed outside the premises.
- -All Cameras shall continually record whilst the premises are open to the public and the recordings shall be kept available for a minimum of 31 days with time and date stamping.
- -Record shall be made available to an authorized officer or police officer within 24 hours of any request.
- -Clear and legible notices to be displayed informing that CCTV is in operation.
- -All seating areas remain in full view of the counter.

## c) Public safety

- -Appropriate fire safety procedures are in place along with appliances ancluding fire extinguishers (Foam, H2O and CO2), Fire blankets, internally illuminated fire exit signs, a smoke detector and emergency lighting.
- -All appliances are checked annually and comply with relevant British Standards.
- -All fire escapes/escape routes will be clearly marked and kept free from obstructions at all times

# d) The prevention of public nuisance

- -All costumer are asked to respect the surroundings and behave in an orderly manner.
- -signs will be installed to remind customers to respect the neighbors and to behave in a courteous manner.
- -Patrons will be discouraged from congregating outside the premises.
- -All waste generated by the premises will be dealt with appropriately.
- -No deliveries of stock are to be made to the premises between 2300 and 0800 on any day only
- -There will be no music to be played at the premises other then background music.
- -All ventilation and extraction systems shall be correctly maintained and regularly serviced to ensure that it operates effectively and with minimal disturbance to neighbours arising from odour.
- -External illumination signs shall be switched off when the premises are closed for licensable activities.
- -Security lights will also be positioned to minimise light intrusion into nearby residential
- -No one shall remain on the premises in the sitting area for consumption of food after 0000 except for staff

# e) The protection of children from harm

-All small ornaments/objects are kept out of reach of children so they wont play with it and swallow it by accidents.

-No alcohol to be sold to persons under the age of 18 and clear signs to be displayed, asking for ID if persons appear to be under-age.
