ALL STAFF UNDERGO TRAINING IN LICENSING AND SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY IN SALE OF ALCOHOL. THE SHOP MANAGEMENT WILL WORK CLOSELY WITH THE LOCAL POLICE TO REDUCE ANY CRIME AND DISORDER.
b) The prevention of crime and disorder
The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system as per the minimum requirements of the Police Licensing Team. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering in any ligh condition. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises is open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum period of 31 days with date and time stamping. Viewing of recordings shall be made available immediately upon the request of the police or an authorised officer throughout the preceding 31 day period.
c) Public safety
PREMISES WILL OPERATE WITH CURRENT LEGAL REQUIREMENT FOR FIRE SAFETY, HEALTH AND SAFETY INCLUDING PERIODIC RISK ASSESSMENT.
d) The prevention of public nuisance
The area immediately outside the premises shall be monitored to ensure that any litter generated by the premises and/or its customers is regularly cleared. The premises licence holder shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that any persons loitering outside the premises disperse quickly and do not congregate.
e) The protection of children from harm

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The "Challenge 25"/"Think 25" proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises. All customers who appear under the age of 25 will be challenged to prove that they are over 18 when attempting to purchase alcohol. Acceptable forms of ID include a photo driving licence, passport, or home office approved identity card baring the holographic 'PASS' mark. If the person seeking alcohol is unable to produce an acceptable form of identification, no sale or supply of alcohol shall be made to or for that person. A diary log shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The log should include the date and time of the refused sale and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The log shall be available for inspection at the premises by the police or an authorised officer of the Council at all times whilst the premises are open.

The premise shall ensure that reasonable and adequate staff training shall be carried out and properly documented in relation to, dealing with incidents and prevention of crime and disorder: sale of alcohol (to underage, persons over 18 purchasing for underage, drunks etc.) prior to being allowed to sell alcohol.

There is an exemption from the payment of fees in relation to the provision of regulated entertainment at church halls, chapel halls or premises of a similar nature, village halls, parish or community halls, or other premises of a similar nature. The costs associated with these licences will be met by central Government. If, however, the licence also authorises the use of the premises for the supply of alcohol or the provision of late night refreshment, a fee will be required.

Schools and sixth form colleges are exempt from the fees associated with the authorisation of regulated entertainment where the entertainment is provided by and at the school or college and for the purposes of the school or college.
