The club will only be open to members over the age of 18.

#### b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Members will be ejected from the premises should they cause any discomfort or distress to other members or staff. Their membership will be revoked.

### c) Public safety

Recordable CCTV is installed in the club and outside the front entrance. The digital recordings are retained for 21 days for inspection by any relevant authority.

## d) The prevention of public nuisance

Any member who in the opinion of the management has had sufficient alcohol will be refused any further drinks.

#### e) The protection of children from harm

Persons under the age of 18 will not be allowed in the premises unless accompanied by a responsible adult. The adult bringing an under 18 into the club will be responsible for the child whilst on the premises. The child will not be allowed to purchase any items from the bar or play on gaming machines.

If, however, the licence also authorises the use of the premises for the supply of alcohol or the provision of late night refreshment, a fee will be required. Schools and sixth form colleges are exempt from the fees associated with the authorisation of regulated entertainment where the entertainment is provided by and at the school or college and for the purposes of the school or college.
