



M Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b, c, d and e) (please read guidance note 9)

We are wholly aware of the licensing objectives and the high importance to ensure that the utmost is done to promote all four of these objectives at all times.

This premises is a restaurant and will be serving full course meals throughout the day and will also be conducting local charity events and events with local community groups. The intention is for this to be a community restaurant and provide a unique experience with the culture of Mexico being the heart.

We believe that all the below all show the overwhelming commitment to promote the licensing objectives and consideration has been given to the published 2010 Local Authority Licensing Policy.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

- 1) There is CCTV installed throughout the premises that will be recording at all times when open to the public.
- 2) The CCTV will be stored on a hard drive system and be kept for at least 31 days.
- 3) The CCTV will be made available upon request from the police and there will be a member of staff on duty at all times who is able to operate and download the CCTV on request.
- 4) There will be a record of any incidents that occurred kept on the premises for inspection by any of the responsible authorities.
- 5) The premises licence holder will actively participate in any relevant and active local watch scheme.
- 6) The premises licence holder will discuss any issues with the local police on a regular basis.
- 7) Alcohol will be served as an ancillary to a meal only.
- 8) Drink Promotions and offers will not take place here at the premises, this is to avoid potential crime and disorder incidents linked to binge drinking.
- 9) As we are only permitted to trade until 11pm, we will not be at risk of attracting large groups of people which is common in discos and promotional events based around the consumption of alcohol.
- 10) No alcohol is to be consumed outside of the premises only within the permitted licensable areas.

c) Public safety

- 1) There will be regular checks of areas such as toilets and entrance areas
- 2) There will be regular checks of emergency exits and these will be recorded and kept at the premises
- 3) The staff will contact taxi's for persons requesting them to prevent patrons waiting outside.
- 4) A full fire risk assessment will be completed and reviewed on a yearly basis
- 5) As there is no fixed seating in the licensable areas, in the event of an emergency customers have easy access to the fire exits if necessary.
- 6) There are two fire exits within the premises ensuring customers are able to leave in emergency quickly and safely
- 7) We are fully equipped with Fire Alarms, Fire Fighting Equipment and Emergency Lighting which are suitable for the assessed risks.
- 8) Adequate training of staff will be undertaken to ensure staff are aware of the procedures to evacuate the customers quickly and safely in the event of an emergency.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

- 1) All doors and windows will remain closed except for access and egress when amplified music is being played inside the premises.
- 2) There will be no purpose played amplified music or voice outside the premises.
- 3) Signs will be displayed at the main exit to remind patrons to leave quietly.
- 4) The delivery of goods and services to the premises are carried out in the basement from the back door, this is a staff only area and ensures all goods are brought in outside of the view of customers.
- 5) If in the event Door Supervisors, Stewards or Security is required we will ensure such staff will be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.
- 6) As Premises Licence holders we will be training the staff in alcohol abuse awareness as part of responsible trading within the Licensed trade.

e) The protection of children from harm

- 1) A Challenge 21 policy will be implemented at the bar area at all times.
- 2) Proof of age will be required with the following forms of ID only:
 - Passport;
 - Photo Card driving licence issued in the European Union;
 - Proof of Age Standards Scheme Card (PASS);
 - Citizen Card supported by the Home Office;
 - Official ID card issued by HM Forces or by a European Union country bearing a photo and date of birth of holder
- 3) As this is a restaurant with an appeal to a wide market range, Children will be permitted to enter the premises and have a meal and proof of ID will be required if they would like to consume alcohol with their meal.
- 4) There will be absolutely no form of Adult Entertainment, and no member of staff that has convictions will be able to serve alcohol to minors, there will be no gambling on site.
- 5) Children under the age of 12 will not be permitted in the restaurant after 9pm without an adult present.

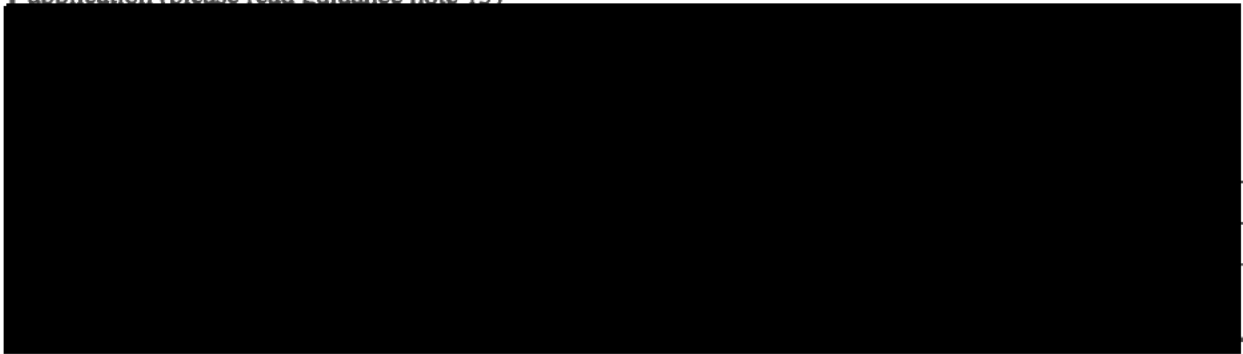

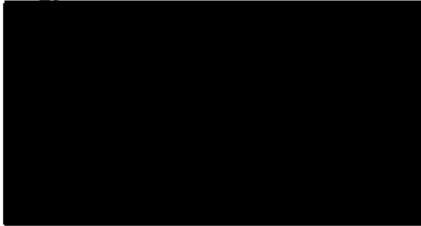

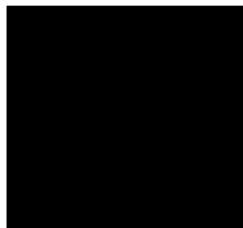
