



 - c. The sale or supply of alcohol to any canteen or mess, being a canteen in which the sale or supply of alcohol is carried out under the authority of the secretary of state or an authorised mess of members of her majesty's naval, military or air forces.

Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions

PLEASE NOTE: MANDATORY CONDITIONS IN GREY DO NOT APPLY

Mandatory conditions where licence authorises supply of alcohol:

- 1 No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -
 - a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
 - b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended
2. Every supply or sale of alcohol made under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Mandatory condition where licence requires door supervision:

Where one or more individuals are required to be at the premises to carry out a security activity, such individual(s) must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

Mandatory Conditions Order 2010

1 – (1) The responsible person shall take such steps as are reasonable to ensure that premises do not carry out, arrange or permit any of the activities listed in paragraph 2.

(2) In this paragraph, the activities listed in paragraph 2 are the supply, or sale, or consumption of alcohol on the premises in a manner which is likely to contribute to crime and disorder, including by public access, public nuisance, or harassment or other activities which are prohibited or restricted under any other enactment, including any enactment relating to the licensing of premises, or any other enactment.

(3) The responsible person shall ensure that any alcohol supplied on the premises before the cessation of the premises licence is sold or supplied in accordance with the provisions of section 119(1) of the Licensing Act 2003, and that the alcohol is sold or supplied in accordance with the provisions of section 119(1) of the Licensing Act 2003, and that the alcohol is sold or supplied in accordance with the provisions of section 119(1) of the Licensing Act 2003.

(4) The responsible person shall ensure that any alcohol supplied on the premises before the cessation of the premises licence is sold or supplied in accordance with the provisions of section 119(1) of the Licensing Act 2003, and that the alcohol is sold or supplied in accordance with the provisions of section 119(1) of the Licensing Act 2003.

(5) The responsible person shall ensure that any alcohol supplied on the premises before the cessation of the premises licence is sold or supplied in accordance with the provisions of section 119(1) of the Licensing Act 2003, and that the alcohol is sold or supplied in accordance with the provisions of section 119(1) of the Licensing Act 2003.

(c) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

2. The responsible person shall ensure that any alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the receptacle container (such as a marked glass) and shall not be dispensed into any receptacle container of a disabled person.

3. The responsible person shall ensure that hot tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

4.—(1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

5. The responsible person shall ensure that

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks are supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold for supply in a sealed container) the responsible person shall apply

(i) beer or other fermented liquor, 25 ml or 50 ml;
(ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky, 25 ml or 50 ml;
(iii) wine in a glass, 125 ml

and customers are made aware of the quantities of alcohol supplied.
