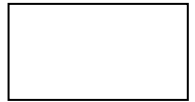

## Please read these notes before completing the form

**Due to new regulations, only electors and their proxies who have been individually registered will be granted a proxy vote.**

1. Please enter your name in Part 1.
2. Please enter your address in Part 2.
3. Please enter the name and address of the person you wish to appoint as your proxy at Part 3. A proxy is someone who will vote on your behalf because you will not be able, or think you will not be able to attend the polling station and vote in person on polling day. Please enter the relationship between you and your proxy. A person is not entitled to vote as proxy on behalf of more than two electors of whom that person is not the husband, wife, parent, grandparent, brother, sister, child or grandchild. Make sure you have spoken to the person you wish to appoint as your proxy. They must be willing to vote on your behalf and be **individually registered**.
4. In Part 4 please give the reason why you will not be able to attend the polling station in person on polling day. **If you do not give a reason your application will be rejected.**
5. Please read Part 5.
6. Please complete your date of birth in Part 6. Use only **black** pen. Please use all 8 boxes. Use zeros where necessary, eg: 09 04 1983
7. Please sign your normal signature inside the grey border of the box in Part 7. **This form must be signed by the elector.** If you are unable to give a signature please contact the Electoral Services office on the number below.
8. Enter the date you completed the form at Part 8 and send the form to the address below. We will inform and your proxy if your application has been granted.

#### **UK Parliamentary Elections 12 December 2019**

All forms must be received by this office no later than **5PM WEDNESDAY 4 DECEMBER 2019** UNLESS this application is replacing an existing postal vote, in which case the deadline is **5PM TUESDAY 26 NOVEMBER 2019**.
