

**The Harrow (Free Parking Places)(Disabled Persons)(Amendment No. 7) Traffic Order 2020**  
**The Harrow (Waiting and Loading restriction) (Amendment No.96) Traffic Order 2020**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on 10<sup>th</sup> February 2020 the London Borough of Harrow made the above mentioned order under Sections 6, 7, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985, and all other enabling powers.
2. The general effect of the order is to amend The Harrow (Free Parking Places) (Disabled Persons) Traffic Order 2017 so as to introduce Free Parking Places for Disabled Persons lawfully displaying Disabled Persons' Badges, so that:-
  - (a) in the spaces listed in the streets specified in Schedule 1 to this notice only motor vehicles displaying a disabled persons badge may wait;
  - (b) the spaces listed in Schedule 2 were deleted;
  - (c) amend The Harrow (Waiting and Loading restriction) Traffic Order 2014, by introducing a new at any time waiting restriction on the western kerb line of Apple Grove to the south of Jupiter House.
3. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 2 above will not apply in respect of anything done at the direction of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer or in certain circumstances which can be provided on request.
4. The orders, which will come into operation on 17<sup>th</sup> February 2020 and other documents giving more detailed particulars are available for inspection between 9am and 5pm, Monday to Friday at the One Stop Shop at the address below, until 6 weeks from the date on which the order was made.
5. If any person wishes to question the validity of the orders or of its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks of the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

## **Schedule 1 – New Disabled Person’s Parking Spaces**

### **Carmelite Road**

the north-east side, outside No. 46 Carmelite Road, with a length of 5.50 metres.

### **Courtenay Avenue**

the service road on the east side, outside No. 30 Courtenay Avenue, with a length of 6.60 metres and a width of 2.20 metres.

### **Drinkwater Road**

the north side, outside No. 7 Drinkwater Road, with a length of 4.80 metres and a width of 3.60 metres.

### **Exeter Road**

the west side, outside No. 55 Exeter Road, with a length of 5.50 metres.

### **Ford Close**

the north side, outside Nos. 25 and 27 Ford Close, with a length of 6.00 metres and a width of 2.20 metres.

### **Howards Close**

the south-west side, outside the entrance to Nos. 10 to 18 Howards Close, with a length of 5.50 metres.

### **Jesmond Way**

the south-east side, between a point 5.70 metres south-west of a point opposite the northern flank wall of Watling Court and a point 5.50 metres south-west of that point.

### **Long Elmes**

the south side, outside Nos. 212 and 214 Long Elmes, with a length of 5.50 metres

### **Osmond Close**

the south side, to the east of No. 52 Osmond Close, with a length of 5.50 metres and a width of 2.70 metres.

### **Rosedale Close**

the south side, outside the entrance to Nos. 1-6 Colman Court, Rosedale Close, with a length of 5.50 metres.

### **Temsford Close**

the north-western corner, outside Nos. 17 and 18 Temsford Close, with a length of 4.80 metres and a width of 3.20 metres.

### **Whittlesea Road**

the west side, opposite No. 40 Whittlesea Road, with a length of 5.50 metres.

## **Schedule 2 – Removed Disabled Person’s Parking Spaces**

### **Culverlands Close**

the east side, outside No. 13 Culverlands Close, with a length of 5.50 metres.

### **Hawkins Close**

the north side, of the eastern arm, within the inset lay-by, with a length of 5.00 metres and a width of 3.20 metres.

### **Hutton Lane**

the west side, outside No. 21 Hutton Lane, with a length of 5.50 metres.

### **Jasmine Gardens**

the north-east side, outside Nos. 10-15 Jasmine Gardens, with a length of 6.60 metres.

### **Kings Road**

the north-west side, outside Nos. 213 and 215 Kings Road, with a length of 5.50 metres.

### **Stanmore Hill**

the south-west side, outside No. 73 Stanmore Hill, with a length of 5.50 metres.

### **Toorack Road**

the south side, outside No. 39 Toorack Road, with a length of 5.50 metres.
