Harrow View, Harrow – Proposed banned U-Turn at central reservation/median strip.

The Harrow (Prescribed Routes) (Amendment No. 5) Traffic Order 2020

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow has made the above mentioned order under Sections 6, 7, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and all other enabling powers.
2. The Harrow (Prescribed Routes) (Amendment No. 5) Traffic Order 2020 creates a banned U-Turn at the northern extremity of the central reservation median strip, located opposite Nos. 347/349 Harrow View.
3. A copy of the order, which will come into operation on 27th February 2020, including documents giving more particulars of the order, are available for inspection at request between 9am and 5pm, Mondays to Fridays at the One Stop Shop at the Civic Centre, until 6 weeks from the date on which the order was made.
4. If any person wishes to question the validity of the order or its provisions on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks of the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
