

Headstone Manor Park

Project progress report February 2020

The refurbishment of the playground is well underway; this includes relocation of some of the existing equipment & the installation of new equipment including a cable way, a mound slide & cradle swings as shown in the images below. Works to de-culvert (open up) the Brook next to the playground will start soon & footpath diversions are in place. The playground will be closed for several more weeks but with all the amazing new equipment it will be worth waiting for!

The new entrance at Pinner View is taking shape as is the learning zone. You may have noticed a low wall of logs – this is the learning zone. The main use of this space will be as a base for school groups as they explore the Brook. Education sessions will involve studying life in the water as well as the impact of water use and pollution. We hope to start some education sessions in the summer term, do get in touch if you would like more information.



The log wall around the learning zone, which will be similar to this one, will be a good habitat for wildlife such as small mammals & spiders & pollinating insects visiting the flowers.

Works on site are being severely hampered by the weather so please bear with us as some parts of the project are taking longer than expected.
