Homelessness and leaving hospital

If you know when you are admitted to hospital that you won't have anywhere to live when you are discharged you should tell the hospital staff as soon as possible.

The hospital's discharge team may be able to help you.

If you are a Harrow resident they may refer you to Harrow Council for housing advice.
