Housing Advice

Homelessness and Pregnancy

You can apply to Harrow Council for help with housing if you are homeless or if you will be homelessness within 56 days.

If you are under 18 you will be referred to Children's Services for support. Harrow's Housing Advice Team's contact details are:

You will be asked for information about your situation and for supporting evidence. This may include proof of pregnancy from a healthcare professional. The council will give you advice about finding somewhere to live. You may be entitled to help in securing accommodation.

Emergency Accommodation

You may be offered emergency accommodation if you are eligible for assistance, have a priority need for housing and have no accommodation that is suitable and available for you to occupy.

Housing Costs

You may be eligible for help with your housing costs from Housing Benefit or Universal Credit.

Domestic Abuse

If you are homeless because of domestic abuse please refer to our leaflet about homelessness and domestic abuse.
