11. Brookshill Drive and Grimsdyke Estate Conservation Area

The conservation area was designated in 1980 and extended in 1986, 1991, 1997, 2006 and 2016.

The Brookshill Drive and Grimsdyke Estate Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Strategy adopted at Cabinet in February 2016 as appendix 2 to the Harrow Weald Conservation Areas SPD.
