

SECTION 14(1)(a) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC
(TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE AND NO WAITING AND NO LOADING RESTRICTIONS
– IMPERIAL DRIVE

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they have made a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to multi utility works to take place.

1. The order shall be cited as The Harrow (Imperial Drive) Temporary Traffic Order 2020 and would be operational between on 5th October 2020 and would remain in effect until 30th January 2021 or until the completion of the works, whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that all works should be completed by 9th October 2020.
2. Vehicles shall be prohibited from entering Imperial Drive service road fronting Nos. 231 – 247 Imperial Drive.
3. Vehicles shall be prohibited from waiting or loading at any time on Imperial Drive service road opposite Nos. 233 and 239 Imperial Drive service road.
4. Nothing in paragraph 2 and 3 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (d) any vehicles used in connection with the utility works;
 - (e) any vehicles needing to gain access to properties in the closed extents as far as is practicably possible.
4. The provisions of the order shall not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
