# Compulsory purchase order

Residents will be aware that in order to ensure the delivery of the regeneration of the estate, the Council needs to acquire a number of legal interests which it has been trying to secure by negotiation.

As a fall back, we undertook the step of seeking a Compulsory Purchase Order and we are pleased to say that the Secretary Of State has confirmed the CPO. Formal notices are being issued to all affected parties as well as being placed on site and in the local press and this will be followed up by relevant correspondence from the Council some time during the course of next month.
