

d) The prevention of public nuisance

No noise or vibration caused as a result of licensable activity at the premises shall be audible at the boundary of any neighbouring residential premises.

Signage will be displayed requesting that patrons respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and area quietly

Notices will be displayed in the function area advising clients that theconsumption of alcohol is only permitted on the pemises.

The venue will not be used during normal office hours for parties or loud music An appropriate automatic noise control devices must be fitted to all amplified sound equipment to be used in the main function room. The device must be:

a) Set so that the volume of any amplified sound emanating from the premises does not cause a public nuisance by being inaudible at the boundary of the premises. A calibration certificate must be supplied to the licensing authority for the installation of the unit before the function rooms come into commission.

For information: The calibration must be carried out by a competent/qualified person and submitted to licensing authority for approval. The calibration certificate must contain the following.

i 5 minute LAEQ

- ii Frequency analysis between 100Hz 40Hz
- b) The device must be fitted to all power outlets to the main function room.
- c) The device must be connected to all external doors inc. fire exit.

Minor Function Room:

- 1. Background music only to be played within the minor function room, and this music is to be played though the supplied in-house system only.
- 2. No external sound equipment to be used within this area.

e) The protection of children from harm

The premises will operate a 'Challenge 21' policy, whereby any person wishing to purchase alcohol, and who appears to be under the age of 18 years, will be asked to provide proof (i.e. passport, driving licence or some other such form of accredited photo identification) that they are over the age of 21 years. Signage will be displayed advising patrons that this scheme is in operation.

A record of age related refusals of service shall be kept and will be made available to officers of the police or local authority upon request.

- A current passport endorsed to show that the holder is allowed to stay in the UK and is currently allowed to
 work and is not subject to a condition preventing the holder from doing work relating to the carrying on of a

- Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman
 wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not
 exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or
 wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an
 indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the
 audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains
 licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
