This variation is to remove the existing condition relating to off sales of alcohol. The current condition restricts off sales to take-away and partly consumed bottles of wine.

We are seeking the removal of this condition.

this would allow the customers to consume alcohol with meals at the front forecourt of the premises.

The condition 1 of Annex 3 also will be amended to read, off sales are either for consumption at the front forecourt or with a take-away meal.

Anyone wishing to oppose this application must do so in writing to the Head of Community Directorate, London Borough of Harrow, Civic Centre, PO box 18, Station Road, Harrow, Middlesex not later than 28 days from the date shown at the top of this notice.

Objections must be based on one or more of the four licensing objectives: prevention of crime and disorder, public safety, prevention of public nuisance and the protection of children from harm.

Please note that any petitions must follow certain rules. Copies of these objections will initially be sent to the applicant for their consideration. Persons objecting to the grant of licences must be prepared to attend in person at a public hearing before the licensing committee of the council.

It is an offence to knowingly or recklessly make a false statement in connection with an application.
