

- **Part 2 Class C:** The painting of the exterior of any building or work. (In relation to the exterior brickwork areas on the front and flank elevations of all properties within the CA).

Part 1 Class C: Any other alteration to the roof of a dwellinghouse (such as the insertion of rooflights or the alteration of roof tiles).



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
