## 24. Pinner Hill Estate Conservation area, Pinner

The Pinner Hill Conservation Area was designated in 1990.

Pinner Hill Conservation Area Appraisal and Management Strategy adopted in December

2009 as appendix 9 to the Pinner Conservation Areas SPD.

Please note that a locally listed park and garden lies partly within and partly in the setting of this Conservation Area ie that named Pinner Hill golf course.

B. The formation, laying out and construction of a means of access to a highway.


