Temporary expansion of Kingsley High School at Weald Rise Primary School

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 the School Organisation (Prescribed Alterations to Maintained Schools) (England) Regulations 2013 that the Harrow Council is proposing to temporarily expand Kingsley High School Whittlesea Road, Harrow HA3 6ND School by 24 additional places. To accommodate the additional pupils, Harrow Council will use vacant classrooms on an additional site, Weald Rise Primary School, Robin Hood Drive, Harrow HA3 7DH from 01 September 2022.

Kingsley High School is an Outstanding Special School and popular with families. It provides 102 places for pupils aged 11 to 19 years of age, Year 7 to Year 13. Harrow Council proposes to open a temporary satellite provision at Weald Rise Primary School using the vacant capacity at the school. Four classes at Weald Rise Primary will be remodelled to create a self-contained provision increasing the capacity of Kingsley High School to cater for an additional 24 students. This additional capacity will increase the number of places at Kingsley High School to 126.
