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1 Introduction

- 1.1 This note is provided by agreement and is principally aimed at the list of venues put forward by members of the public at the inquiry on 11th October (List A). But like the appellant and for completeness, I also refer to a second list produced by a member of the public on 13th October, and this is referred to as List B, although greater emphasis in this note is on the venues in List A.
- 1.2 For the purposes of this note I rely on the following sources of information:
 - Venue website extracts
 - 2. Questionnaire survey sent to venues on 14th and 17th/18th October which I asked the following questions:
 - Does your venue host south-Asian and other ethnic weddings?
 - What number of people can you accommodate for a seated wedding reception at your venue?
 - Are there any barriers to hosting south-Asian and other ethnic weddings at your venue?
 - Do you have sufficient ceiling height in order to accommodate stage and Mandaps?
 Please provide photographic evidence if possible
 - Are you able to accommodate gender segregated events?
 - Do you offer in house catering option (including vegetarian/halal)?
 - Can customers use external caterers?
 - Are you able to meet a requirement for the handling of specific food and beverages which may include the consumption of specific food types or include the exclusion of others?
 - Are you able to host a celebration which may involve a number of events spanning a number of days?
 - How in demand are your services currently?
 - Do you have many vacancies in your bookings over the next 12 months?
 - What number of vacancies do you have for both weekdays and weekends over the next 12 months?
 - What on-site parking arrangements do you have and how many parking spaces?
 - Do you have an over-flow car parking contingency?
 - Do you offer wedding packages including catering decorating and photography and other services?
 - What are your opening hours and what days are you open?

Analysis - List A

- In relation to the venues already covered the KP Centre have confirmed that they currently host around 100 to 125 weddings a year plus other events but have capacity for further weddings to take place. They have outlined that there is no restriction in term so of external catering and the hirer has choice of selecting their own caterer, decorator and other suppliers including for provision of facilities for gender segregation if required. A follow up telephone call with the venue on the 25th October confirmed the venue is currently about 45% booked over the next 12 month and the venue is open to all religions and faiths.
- Of the seven venues identified in Harrow in terms of those that can accommodate a seated capacity of 300 plus, from the information I have gathered indicates that Shree Swaminarayan Temple, Husseini Islamic Centre and Harrow Central Mosque should be treated as venues which make significant contributions to South Asian Wedding venues in the borough. In addition, the Blue Room is also considered to make some contribution to the overall venue offer for South Asian weddings.
- Although Victoria Hall is below the guest capacity of 300, this venue has confirmed it is still able to host South Asian weddings and would therefore continue to make a contribution.
- In respect of the seven venues in Harrow, although the exact offering has shades of variation, six of the venues still provide a wide range of choice of venues for South Asian and ethnic communities for weddings and other events. It is acknowledged that the Salaam Centre in North Harrow is not yet operational but its website indicates the building will be completed by January 2024 and as such it is likely to make a contribution in the near future.
- In relation to the three venues in the appellants sub area not previously covered (Bushey Arena, Kenton Hall, Mecure London Watford), it is acknowledged that Kenton Hall and Mecure London Watford Hotel would not be able to accommodate for 300 guests but would nevertheless still make a contribution to the overall South Asian/ethnic wedding market. The Kenton Hall can accommodate a maximum of 200 guests and the Mecure London Watford Hotel 180 guests. In respect of Bushey Arena, this has capacity to accommodate 300 plus guests, it can accommodate Mandaps, gender segregated events and can recommend external catering or allow couples to arrange their own catering. The venue is multi-functional but it has a range of different spaces for hire which can be hired independently. There is no evidence to suggest that a wedding can't take place at the same time as one of the other halls is in use for a different function.
- In respect of the other two venues in the wider area, the Navnat Centre and Oshwal Centre, from the information I have gathered, it is clear that these additional venues should also be treated as venues which make a significant contribution to the South Asian/ethnic wedding market. Both venues can accommodate 300 plus guests. The Navnat centre has indicated they have 70% vacancies in their bookings for weekends and weekdays. It has sufficient space for mandaps, can accommodate gender segregated events and has indicated they can provide food and



beverage requirements but also allow external catering. The site also has a large car park capacity for 400 cars. The only barrier identified by the venue is that they do not allow alcohol or meat. However, if they did allow alcohol and/or meat then my understanding (see for example site specific information for Shree Swaminarayan Temple) is that this would be a barrier to some of those in the South Asian community who would not hold an event in a venue where meat and/or alcohol is served. Nevertheless, they would still provide a choice for a large range of people within south Asian and ethnic communities. The Oshwal centre advertises its venue as 'the perfect venue for your wedding and for celebrating all your special occasions'. It has onsite parking capacity for over 500 cars. The Google reviews (as set out below) clearly indicate this venue is a popular wedding venue for the South Asian Community. Following a telephone call, with one of the event managers, although the venue is busy, there remains good availability for wedding dates at the current time into 2023 and 2024 (see site further information below). This venue can accommodate people of all backgrounds and faiths. The venue is restricted by only 30 days in the year where it cannot hold weddings due to religious events but is available on all other days of the year.

Based on the information gathered from other venues in Harrow, the appellants sub area and in
the wider area, there is no evidence to suggest venues are operating at capacity and are unable
to cope with the demand for the South Asian/ethnic wedding market across all religious groups


The KP Centre sent a further email to me on 14th October and confirmed the following:

- The venue offers dry hire only but there are no restrictions on the hirer in selecting their own caterer, decorator and other suppliers
- The venue typically hosts between 100 to 125 South Asian weddings a year and weddings tend to be booked 12 to 18 months in advance.
- A follow up telephone call with the venue on the 25th October confirmed the venue is currently about 45% booked over the next 12 month and the venue is open to all religions and faiths.




Further Information

I visited the Blue Room Sports Venue on Tuesday 17th November and was shown around by one of the managers (Mr Naresh Patel). The venue has 3 function halls. The main function Hall can accommodate 500 to 600 guests and can allow for gender segregated events. Although the venue tended to cater more for birthday parties/engagements, it was confirmed by the manager that the venue was able to cater for weddings. It was outlined that the venue did have a restriction on ceiling height for larger Mandaps but it was still able to provide space for smaller Mandaps and had done so in the past. I was advised that the restaurant was in use on the first floor but events could take place in the main function halls at any time. The venue could offer catering but also offered people flexibility to bring in their own catering.






Blue room main function hall






2. Shree Swaminarayan Temple, Wood Lane

I received the following email response from one of the temple trustees on 19th October:

"Our Temple is situated in a quiet area of Wood Lane, Stanmore on the land of 18 acres of Pristine woodland and open space. We opened our Temple in 2006 and since then have been serving the Hindu and local community for prayers and other religious activities such as religious weddings, engagements, and receptions to name a few. We have three function venues on the site: the main hall accommodating 500 guests, a marquee accommodating 400 guests and a smaller function hall accommodating 200 guests. We also have facilities to carry outdoor weddings on our grounds.

We offer a fully inclusive (One stop shop) service for religious weddings and other functions, this includes catering for sanctified vegetarian food, mandaps, decorations, priests, and sound systems. However, we appreciate the need for choice so guests are able to choose their own mandaps, decorations, priests, and sound systems from other suppliers. With regards to the wedding ceremony, we are registered to provide civil weddings. The Temple has a large following in Harrow and the surrounding areas.

Due to the range of facilities and the large pool of well-trained staff and volunteers, we have the flexibility to have multiple functions on the same day e.g., we can accommodate two weddings in two of our function halls. Indian weddings tend to have the wedding in the morning and a reception in the evening and this turns out to be two functions as our clients often want different décor and table arrangements for their functions, we are able to provide all of this to our guests. With the range of facilities we have, we are also able to provide segregated facilities for patrons who require this.

We have not needed any additional parking even when all our function venues and a Temple function have been running at the same time. However, if an event did occur that would exceed our parking spaces, then we could have access to the nearby rugby club parking facilities which is a 2-minute walk from the Temple.

Even though we are a popular venue and have many advanced bookings we still have many dates available for both weekdays and weekends.

We provide in-house catering. Our cuisine is pure vegetarian and sanctified food and we have a range of menus to satisfy client wishes. Our religious beliefs and traditions, supported by various scriptures, precludes us from serving meat and alcohol on our premises and this actually reassures our clients, many of whom will not even set foot on premises that serve meat and



alcohol. In doing so we not only provide a very essential and bespoke service for the Indian community who are our major patrons but also provide a service that many wedding venues would not be able to match as they cook and serve meat. We believe that the range of our menus is capable of satisfying all palates and given the demand for weddings at our Temple, we do not believe it stops anyone from having their function at the Temple.

In fact, many of our clients prefer to get married at a place of worship which gives them the added reassurance of religious blessings of their union. It is believed by some that auspicious days in the Indian calendar mark the days on which people can get married. This is not true as these days are regarded as days that are lucky for getting married to increase the odds of a happy successful marriage. These days are not there to stop people from getting married on other days. Our venues are therefore available and booked for weddings throughout the year.

In a similar fashion, there are several one-and-a-half-hour auspicious times windows throughout every day of the week called 'muhurat' when a ceremony started in that window is supposed to bode well for a couple's happiness and prosperity. Again, this is simply a means of improving people's chances of a happy life, but this does not appear to stop people from getting married at other times of the day.

This concept of auspiciousness on certain days is there to increase the odds of a happy marriage but not to prevent the marriage.

We also provide our own Mandaps for weddings. The concept of a mandap is having four pillars and a canopy. There is no requirement for a Mandap to be of a certain height. A mandap is often placed on a stage to enable a clear all-around view of the wedding for the guests, but there is no requirement for the Mandap to be on a stage. The mandaps are sometimes at different heights and this is entirely the choice of a couple. There is no religious requirement for a mandap to be a certain height.

We attract people of all ages who come to worship and learn about the Hindu religion, culture, and traditions at the Temple. Recognising that the young are our future, we actively encourage the engagement of the younger generation in our activities. We run religious, cultural, and language classes at the Temple. We have a very large pool of volunteers of all ages who support our activities.

We take note that there are other sister Temples that offer similar facilities namely Shree Swaminarayan Temple Willesden, Temple which offers similar facilities in Brent together with purpose-built Parking suitable to cater to its needs."



Further Information

I visited the Wood Lane temple on Tuesday 17th October. I was shown around the various event rooms by one of the temple trustees which included an external marquee and two large event halls which are shown in the images below. I was advised that the site regularly hosts events and three events can be accommodated at the same time. The main event hall can accommodate 500 guests, the external Marque 400 guests and the smaller event hall 200 guests.


I was advised that since Covid events including weddings are becoming smaller. The site has good availability throughout the year and can host events all year round. I was advised that there was no restriction at the site to get married on any particular date. It was outlined that there had been a slight backlog since Covid but this had now gone. The venue can provide for vegetarian catering, decoration and Mandaps as well as segregation (although they don't have a requirement for segregation in their religion). However, people also had the option to use external catering if they chose to. It was also pointed out that it is the bride who dictates the location of the wedding which is usually the location where they have family and were brought up. The trustee outlined that although he lived in the local area, his own wedding was in Cardiff as that was where his wife was from and not because they couldn't find a venue in Harrow. I saw that there was large parking availability on site in three separate parking area with space for a very large number of vehicles. The trustee outlined that because of the onsite parking space they rarely needed overflow parking space but that if required this could be provided by the adjacent Islamic temple or Rugby club opposite the site. The photographs below were taken on my visit.

In relation to the marquee on site, it is noted that the appellant outlined they could not find a record of planning consent. The Council are aware that the Marquee is not on site permanently and is put up as a temporary structure under permitted development rights when needed for events.


Further Information

I tried to contact the venue between 20th and 25th October but was not able to get through to anyone who was able to advise. The venue website indicates it can accommodate 350 guests in one of its halls. The venue website outlines that only approved caterers are permitted to cook or provide catering facilities. The web site notes that Nilkant hall can be hired between 1030 and 330pm on Sundays only and can be used for specific events such as engagements and birthday parties. It doesn't rule out weddings but it is not clear from the venue website whether they can be accommodated.



4. Husseini Islamic Centre

I received the following email response from the temple on Friday 21st October:

"Further to your visit to our Centre last week, and requested some information, regarding the activities at our Centre.

We accommodate the following activities:


- We are authorised to conduct the Civil weddings.
- We provide wedding services to our membership and the events are segregated with inhouse catering.
- We provide Meeting services, prayers etc.
- Please find attached photos as requested at visit."

Further Information:

I visited the Huseinni Islamic Centre on Tuesday 17th October. I was shown around the ladies and gents room shown in purple and pink on the above floorplan taken from the venue website. The lady's room is able to cater for events for 500 people, but overall function capacity was upto 1200 people. It was outlined that the venue has lots of availability for weddings, despite their being two months of the year when weddings were restricted due to religion (the specific restrictive dates would change each year). I was advised that because the venue is a holy site, there is a requirement for gender segregation but in other non-religious venues, there was no specific requirement for gender segregation. The venue is able to accommodate Mandaps and can also host two separate weddings at the same time and had done so very recently. The site has parking capacity for 200 cars but also has use of the adjacent Wood Lane temple parking and rugby ground which has space for around 300 cars. The venue provides its own catering but also allow external catering provided it is halal. Below are some images of the ladies and gent's hall at the venue.



Part of Ladies Hall




Part of Gents Hall

Further Information

I visited the Harrow Central Mosque on Tuesday 17th October. I saw that there was a large function hall on the ground floor available for wedding functions. The venue has capacity to accommodate 300 plus guests, permits external catering, has sufficient space for Mandaps and can accommodate gender segregation. There is a large number of parking spaces (550) opposite the site in the Harrow Civic Centre which the mosque has access to. It is evident from the



reviews on google that the venue is well known for hosting weddings. Please refer to some of the google reviews below:

"Great mosque and venue for weddings. Had my wedding here and the service is great. Brother Ahmed and Ashfaq are fantastic and had everything sorted for the big day.





- Do you have many vacancies in your bookings over the next 12 months? The numbers available depend on the months you are looking at

- What on-site parking arrangements do you have and how many parking spaces? 23 total onsite underground
- Do you have an over-flow car parking contingency? I direct requests to the old Debenhams car park, as it is reasonable
- Do you offer wedding packages including catering decorating and photography and other services? No, we can rec. those we know of.
- What are your opening hours and what days are you open? We are open to accommodate booked events from 9-5pm, we accommodate evening events Monday to Friday until 11pm on request. Saturday opening depends on events pre- booked in our calendar (10am-11pm). To view our spaces, this needs to be booked prior to arrival, as we do not allow events to be disturbed for viewings. Sunday has been pre-booked until Sept 2023.


Further Information

Victoria Hall has three separate function rooms where the spaces can be combined. Spaces one and 2 can be combined to accommodate 250 guests and if space 3 is also combined 329 guests can be accommodated. It is possible to accommodate gender segregated events as each of the rooms has individual access doors. The appellant notes that this would be restricted to 79 men or women but the individual rooms can accommodate capacities of 200, 50 and 79 which would therefore allow for greater segregation.




The Salaam Centre web site states that "The Salaam Centre seeks to create a place where people of all faiths or none feel that they can enter and participate...with a wide range of facilities and a welcoming attitude, we feel we can cater for the physical, intellectual and spiritual needs of people for all works of life age and gender". The Salaam Centre will be large building (5000 sqm) and will include a range of facilities including a multi-functional hall. Given the scale of the building, it is highly likely it will accommodate more than 300 plus guests but the final offering and guest capacity is not confirmed.






Five telephone calls were made to the venue between 21st and 24th October but I was unable to get through to anyone. 





The appellant indicates that the venue would not be able to accommodate gender segregation if there were more than 70 men or women as the smaller events hall can only accommodate 70 people. However, my understanding from conversation with other venues is that there are means of providing gender segregation through the provision of room dividers. This is also indicated in the survey response above that the hirer can engage third parties to accommodate this. The venue is dry hire but there are no restrictions on religious grounds or catering and hirer has flexibility to engage external suppliers.

I telephoned the venue on 25th October and spoke to one of the event managers at the site. He advised that the venue was busy but still had good availability for weddings and was usually able to accommodate most people's dates preferences. He gave an example that in February 2023, there were two weekends booked but so far only 4 or 5 weddings booked for 2024. The manager advised that there were only 30 dates available in the year when people were unable to get married due to religious events but the rest of the year the large halls were available for wedding hire. He noted that the only restriction on the venue was that they were strictly vegetarian and no alcohol. He outlined that the Oshwal Centre welcomed any faith or religion for weddings, including Hindu, Muslim and Jewish and that they regularly host different weddings of different faiths at the same time. The venue is dry hire only but offers complete flexibility for customers to use external caterers, photography companies, décor companies including for Mandaps. It was confirmed the venue can host gender segregated events and has one site parking space for 500 cars.

The venue website outlines that the "Oshwal Centre, Potters Bar, is the perfect venue for your wedding and for celebrating all your special occasions. Set in idyllic surroundings with the magnificent Jain Temple located within its own landscaped gardens and recently fully refurbished modern halls, the venue offers a perfect interlace of tranquil traditional authenticity and modern design."

The venue offers a range of facilities including

2 large halls each with maximum capacity of 500 people; State of the art lighting and sound system; Registered venue for performing civil marriages; 3 Spacious changing rooms; 6 Plasma Screens in the upstairs hall; 3 Plasma Screens in the downstairs hall; Wi-fi Access; On-site parking for 500 cars; On-site Children's play area; 2 Spacious kitchens; Projector Screen; Tables & Chairs; Disabled step-free access & lift.

The halls are able to accommodate Mandaps and can accommodate gender segregated events. Customers can also choose to bring in external suppliers for décor and catering.

In addition to the 2 large halls, the venue also offers the newly extended and refurbished Oshwal House, with standing capacity of 150, seated (theatre style) 100 and seated (with tables) 75.

Analysis List B

- Of the three venues in Harrow not previously considered, it is clear that the Sangam Association of Asian Women and the Shrinathdam National Haveli Centre should be considered as relevant venues for making a contribution towards meeting the needs for South/Asian ethnic wedding venues. Both of these venues have capacity for 300 guests. Although the Masefield Suite is discounted from the appellants evidence as a result of guest capacity, the event manager confirmed to me that the Venue can accommodate 250 guests and would still make a contribution to the overall South Asian/Ethnic wedding market.
- Of the three venues in the appellants sub regional market area, it is evident that The Grove and the Penridge suite can accommodate a seated guest capacity of 300 guests and therefore should be considered as relevant in the overall contribution to the South Asian/ethnic wedding market. It is noted that Ms Gilham appears to discount the Grove on the basis of price, in my view it should not be excluded from other venues which should be considered relevant, unlike Ms Gilham at paragraph 17 I did not interpret the evidence given by members of the public given at the inquiry that only inexpensive venues should be considered relevant. I understood their point to be those inexpensive venues, such as schools, should not be regarded as irrelevant on account of offering less expensive options.
- In respect of the four venues identified in the wider area, these were all identified in my proof of evidence as being suitable and available to host South Asian/ethnic wedding for guest capacities in excess of 300. It should be noted that 3 out 4 of these venues is specifically dedicated to banqueting/functions (Saffron D'OR, Stockley Marquee and VUK) and offers a wide range of options for catering, décor, packages. North Mymms Park, although also a hotel, has a particular focus on multi cultural weddings and advertises itself as the one of the premier multicultural wedding venues in the UK so it is also clearly a venue which is highly relevant and should be considered as part of the overall market offer for the South Asian community.
- 60% of the venues I was able to get in touch with, all indicated they had good availability of dates
 for the next 12 month period and this was also taking into account dates of the year when events
 can't take place in some venues such as the Oshwal Centre. This clearly shows there is not an
 unmet need for this type of venue.
- The venues offer degrees of variation compared to the former Premier Banqueting site but all provide a relevant contribution to the overall market for South Asian /ethnic wedding venues.

Religion of Each Venue

- I note Ms Gilhams Appendix 3. However, it should be noted that the proposed offering at Premier House which include a range dietary requirements and provision for alcohol will exclude a significant part of the Hindu community from being able to use their venue which strictly adhere to a vegetarian diet and no alcohol. This was confirmed by one of the Trustees during my visit to the Wood Lane temple in Stanmore. It was also confirmed to me through a contact on one of my visits that some in the Muslim community would also not enter a venue where alcohol or non halal meet is served.
- I disagree with Ms Gilhams categorisation of Harrow School as a venue for the Christian
 Community. It is clear the school is not restrictive from my own evidence and that it hosts Asian weddings, an offering which is implicit on their web site
- Ms Gilham has not categorised Canons Park School. However, based on email correspondence received from the school as discussed in my evidence, my understanding is that it is not restrictive.
- I disagree with Ms Gilhams classification of the KP Centre, SP Centre, the Dhamecha Lohana
 Centre and Shrinathdham National Haveli and Community Centre as Hindu only. The venues are
 open to all faiths and religions as confirmed by a telephone calls to the venues on the 25^{th of}
 October.
