Chaiiwala is an exciting franchise that serves Indian Street Food and speciality brewed teas (Chaii). Originating from the far east, Chaiiwala brings a modern mix of delicious and affordable Indian street food, with a contemporary twist and flavoursome varieties of Chaii.			
The applicants, Square Guys H Ltd is part of the Square Guys Ltd Group of which currently own and operate The Chaiiwala in Kingsbury, Shepherds Bush and soon to open in Watford.			
No alcohol is served at Chaiiwala, and there is no intention for this to ever change as it is not part of the business model. You will note that the current premises licence which has recently been transferred to the hands of Square Guys H Ltd does have the sale of alcohol as a licensable activity. On transfer the company officially removed the DPS from the licence.			
The applicants are experienced in running such venues. This is not a common fast food premises per se, unlike other late night food outlets, they attract a certain customer for their bespoke food and drinks and tend to be a destination venue rather than somewhere one may pop in at the end of a night out, or just passing by.

2. The premises licence holder or nominated representative shall keep and maintain all right to work documents for all staff members. Right to work documents shall be kept at the premises or accessible digitally and produced to authorised officers of the local authority or the Police upon request. Right to work documents must be retained at the premises for a minimum of 12 months after employment has ceased.

3. CCTV shall be installed, operated and maintained at all times that the premises is open for licensable activities, so as to comply with the following criteria;

• The licensee will ensure that the system is checked every two weeks to ensure that the system is working properly and that the date and time are correct. A record of these checks, showing the date and time of the person checking, shall be kept and made available to police or authorised council officers on request

The police must be informed if the system will not be operating for longer than one day of business for any reason
One camera will show a close-up of the entrance to the premises, to capture a clear, full length image of anyone entering
The system will provide coverage of any exterior part of the premises accessible to the public

• The system shall record in real time and recordings will be date and time stamped

 Recordings will be kept for a minimum of 31 days and downloaded footage will be provided free of charge to police or authorised council officers on request, (subject to the Data Protection Act 1998) within 24 hours of any request, and
 At all times the premises are open for licensable activity, there will be a person on the premises who can operate the system sufficiently to allow police or authorised council officers to view footage on request

4. Signage stating that CCTV is in operation at the premises will be clearly displayed at the premises

5. Adequate and appropriate supply of first aid equipment and materials must be available on the premises at all times

6. Staff will attend to any spillages within the venue as soon as practicable to minimise risk of injury to customers.

7. Clear notices must be prominently displayed requesting customers to leave the premises and the area in a quiet and orderly manner.

8. No persons carrying open vessels of alcohol must be admitted to the premises at any time.

9. Delivery drivers should be asked to keep noise to a minimum when collecting takeaways and must not be permitted to loiter unnecessarily.

10. Staff training must be documented and based on legislation and operating procedures. All training shall be signed and dated and a copy of such records will be available for inspection by Police and local authority enforcement officers.

11. The removal of rubbish to outside the premises will not take place between 2200 hours and 0700 hours

12. Waste must not be placed externally between the hours of 21.00hrs and 08.00hrs.

13. During licensable hours there will always be a minimum of two members of staff present

14. The licensee will provide adequate bins for use by customers and encourage their use

15. Staff shall carryout regular checks to ensure the area outside of the premises is clear of litter, to monitor customer behaviour and to ensure there is no outbreak of noise from the premises.

16. Staff will be trained to identify signs of intoxication, suspicious or aggressive behaviour and how to appropriately deal with such customers so as to provide adequate care and minimise risk

17. The licensee undertakes to use only experienced and reputable delivery companies

18. Where chairs and tables are provided, internal gangways are kept unobstructed

In terms of specific regulated entertainments please note that:

- Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
- Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
- Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
- Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
 - Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
