SECTION 14(1)(a) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - MASONS AVENUE & HERGA ROAD

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they intend to make a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to facilitate highway maintenance works.

- 1. The order may be cited as The Harrow (Masons Avenue and Herga Road) Temporary Traffic Order 2023, and shall be operational between 22:00hrs and 06:00hrs on 14th July 2023 and shall remain in effect until 14th September 2023 or until the completion of the works, whichever is the sooner. It is anticipated that all of the work should be complete by 14th July 2023.
- 2. Vehicles shall be prohibited from entering or exiting Masons Avenue, between its junctions with High Street, Wealdstone and Byron Road, Wealdstone.
- 3. Vehicles shall be prohibited from turning right into Masons Avenue from The Bridge.
- 4. Vehicles shall be prohibited from waiting or loading, when signs are in place on;
 - (a) Masons Avenue, the north side;
 - i. Between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 79 and 81 Masons Avenue and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 81 and 83 Masons Avenue
 - ii. Between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 97 and 99 Masons Avenue and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 103 and 105 Masons Avenue;
 - (b) Herga Road;
 - i. The south side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 6 and 8 Herga Road and a point opposite the north-western boundary wall of No. 24 Herga Road;
 - ii. The south side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 32 and 34 Herga Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 38 an 40 Herga Road;
 - iii. The north side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 29 and 31 Herga Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 35 and 37 Herga Road;
 - iv. The south side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 58 and 60 Herga Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 64 and 66 Herga Road;
 - v. The north side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 63 and 65 Herga Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 67 and 69 Herga Road;
 - vi. The south side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 100 and 102 Herga Road and a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 106 and 108 Herga Road;
 - vii. The north side, between a point opposite the party wall of Nos. 103 and 105 Herga Road and a point opposite the eastern boundary wall of No. 109 Herga Road;
 - viii. The north side, between a point opposite the western boundary wall of No. 115 Herga Road and a point opposite the eastern boundary wall of No. 123 Herga Road
 - ix. The south side, between a point opposite the south-western boundary wall of No. 146 Herga Road and a point opposite the north-eastern boundary wall of No. 146 Herga Road.
- 5. Nothing in paragraph 2 to 4 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984:
 - (d) any vehicles used in connection with the highway maintenance works;
 - (e) any vehicles needing to gain access to properties in the closed extents as far as is practicably possible.
- 4. The provisions of the order will not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.

5. Diversion route; via High Street, Wealdstone, Palmerston Road, Oxford Road and Byron Road, Wealdstone and vice versa.
