SECTION 14(1)(a) ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED BY THE ROAD TRAFFIC (TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE - MILTON ROAD

THE COUNCIL OF THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HARROW HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that they have made a Temporary Traffic Management order under the provisions of Section 14 (1) (a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991. This is to facilitate multi utility works.

- 1. The order shall be cited as The Harrow (Milton Road) Temporary Traffic Order 2023, and shall be operational on 27th April 2023 and would remain in effect for a maximum legal duration of 18 months, or the completion of works, whichever is sooner.
- 2. Vehicles shall be prohibited from entering or exiting Milton Road between its junctions with Station Road and Poets Way.
- 3. Vehicles shall be prohibited from travelling in a southbound direction on Milton Road between its junctions with Station Road and Poets Way.
- 4. Nothing in paragraph 2 above shall apply to:-
 - (a) any vehicles being used for ambulance, fire brigade or police purposes in an emergency;
 - (b) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (c) any person who causes any vehicle to proceed in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to Section 66 or Section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
 - (d) any vehicles used in connection with the multi utility works;
 - (e) any vehicles needing to gain access to properties in the closed extents as far as is practicably possible.
- 4. The provisions of the order shall not have effect unless all the signs in accordance with the provisions of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 are displayed, removed or covered, or unless at the direction of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer.
- 5. Diversion route; via Milton Road, Marlborough Hill, Station Road
